World War Two Searchlights

The men who stayed behind made the searchlights for the war. These men stayed because they were not medically fit to go to war or they had an important job back home.

These searchlights were used to find aircraft flying over their town. When aircraft was spotted the town would go through what is called a black out. This is where people had no lights on so the aircraft could not see them and therefore they would be unable to drop bombs.
