

Creating Healthier Workplaces

Influenza Vaccination Program 2012

As part of the Department's ongoing commitment to health, safety and wellbeing, all schools, TAFEs and other DET workplaces are able to access influenza vaccination services via a preferred supplier arrangement with **Medimobile Flu Services**. This program builds upon the excellent practices already existing in many departmental workplaces.

- Service:** Vaccination clinic held at your school/TAFE/workplace.
- Cost:** \$24.20 including GST per person
- Participation:** Voluntary.
It is the decision of the principal/manager of the work group to support staff wishing to take part in the Influenza Vaccination Program. Schools/TAFEs and other departmental workplaces that have alternative arrangements in place are not required to use the preferred supplier.
- Funding:** The decision as to whether the vaccination cost is met or subsidised from departmental resources is for the local Principal/Manager to determine. **Medimobile** will produce one invoice for each workplace.
- Procedure:** Nominate a contact person at your school/TAFE/workplace to liaise with **Medimobile** personnel. **Medimobile** uses a secure online booking system to help organize and manage clinics.

To arrange a vaccination clinic at your school / TAFE institute / DET workplace, Flu Program coordinators can contact Medimobile directly*.

Once a School/TAFE/workplace has determined that they will participate in the vaccination program, **Medimobile** should be contacted immediately to confirm participation.

- Cancellations:** 5 working days notice must be given to cancel an entire clinic without penalty. Cancellation fees are based on the number of confirmed participants. Cancellations within 5 working days attract a 50% fee of the quoted per person rate and within 3 working days attract a fee of 100% of the quoted per person rate.

Registrations can be made now for 2012.
