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Process for Teacher Applicants within the North Coast Region

The following information is provided for applicants seeking employment as a teacher in a Queensland state school who are:

- Residing in the North Coast Region;
- Currently undertaking an internship or final professional experience in the North Coast Region;
- Are currently teaching in a school within the North Coast Region; or
- Wishing to undertake a reassessment of their suitability ranking within the North Coast Region.

Interview and assessment panels are formed at the discretion of each regional office and in response to the number of applicants requiring interviews across the school year. The statewide assessment process undertaken by each panel will be the same regardless of how, when and where the panel is formed.

Graduate applicants who are completing their final professional experience/internship, along with other general applicants, should submit their *Application for Teacher Employment* form to the Teacher Applicant Centre (TAC) to ensure they are on the 'Request for Assessment' list provided to the region.

On receipt of the applicant's details from TAC, the region will advise applicants via email the details of the interview process including how/where to submit their Professional Folio.

Preparing the Professional Folio

Reassessment

Applicants may request a reassessment of a suitability ranking when they have performed a total of 100 days of temporary employment and/or casual teaching since their last assessment.
