## Navigating your Virtual Classroom

In your Virtual Classroom navigate using the menu on the left hand side. Below is the standard navigation created for a school Virtual Classroom. Your schools version may vary slightly.

HOME	<b>HOME</b>	Course entry point and is available to all enrolled staff and students. Add further announcements as needed.
Plans	<b>Plans</b>	Content area containing Learning Plan templates. Add your own school plans or modify existing.
Year 8	<b>Year levels</b>	Content areas containing resources arranged by year level, subject and topic. Add and modify to suit your students' learning needs.
Year 9	<b>Student lounge</b>	Discussion board for students and available to staff. Make sure staff check this regularly.
Year 10	<b>Principal's blog</b>	Students and staff can access updates from the Principal and communicate through questions and comments. It's a blog so is based on a calendar.
Years 11 - 12	<b>Staffroom</b>	Discussion board for staff. Students will not have access to this area.
Student Lounge	<b>How to</b>	Contains help, support and contact information.
