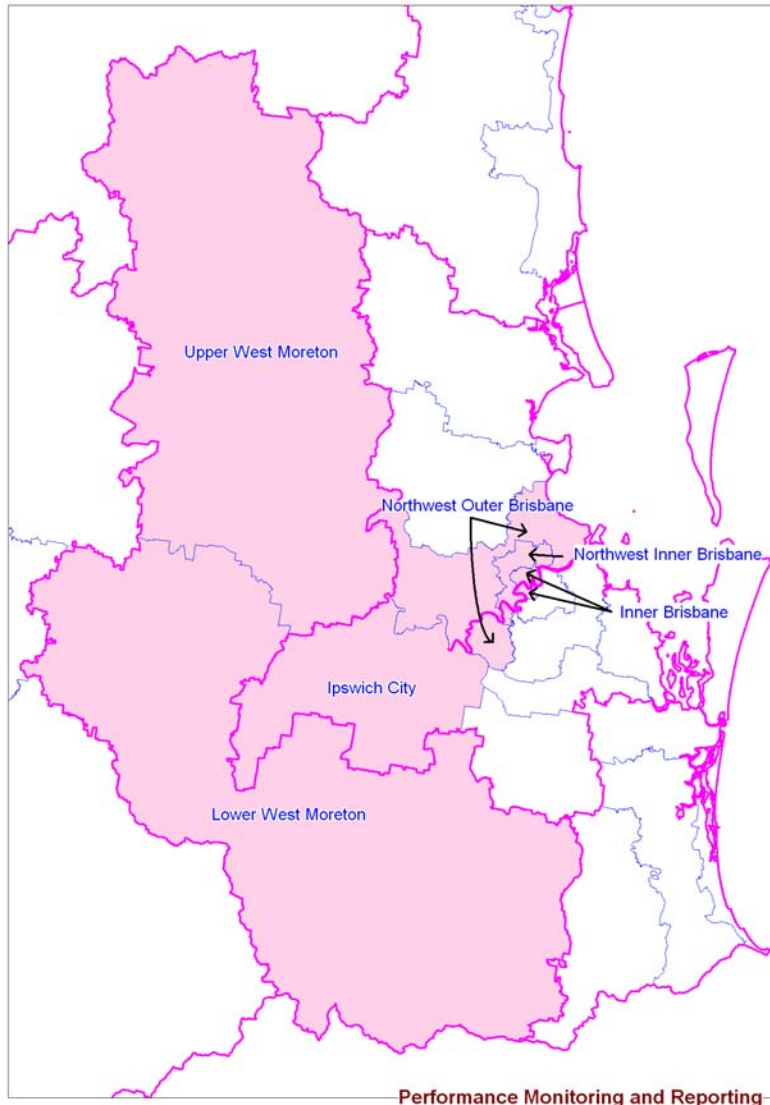

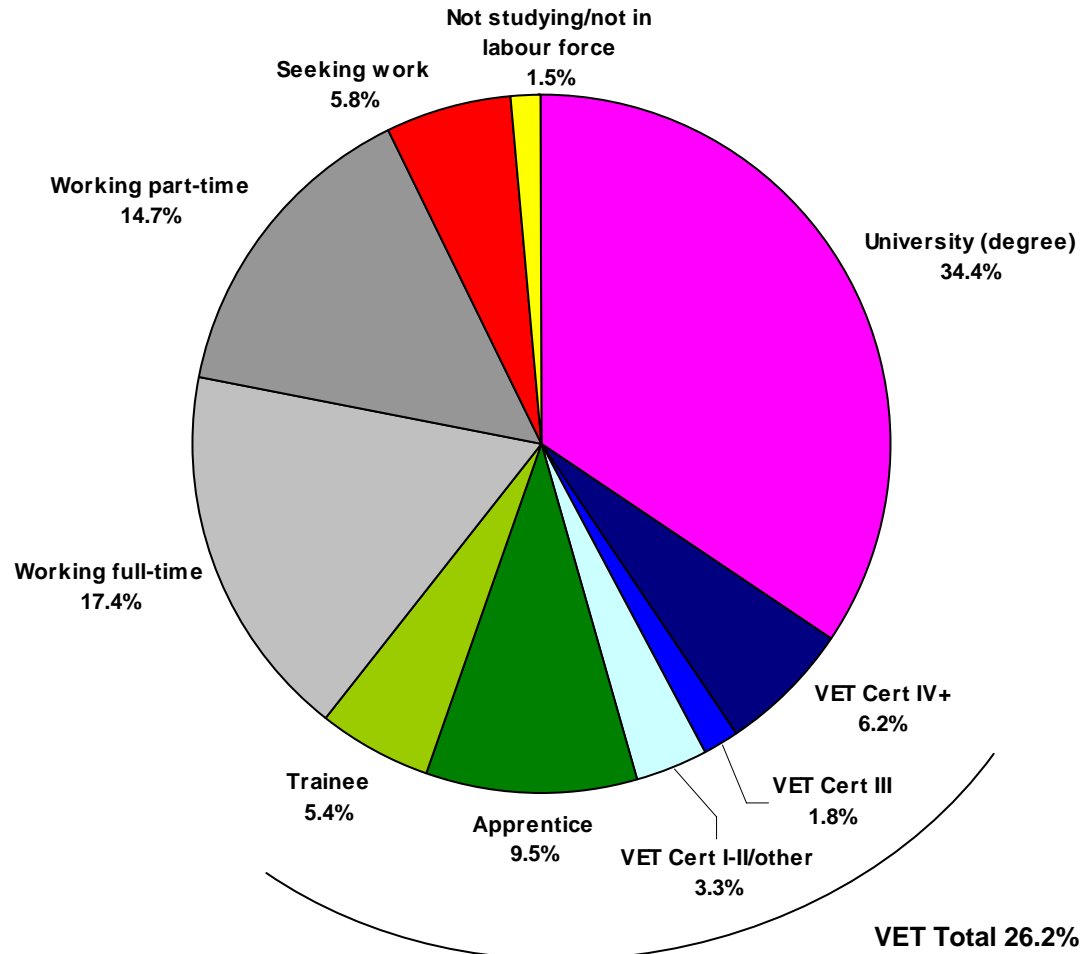
- 16 111 respondents (Response rate = 81.3%)
- 7856 male respondents (Response rate = 80.5%)
- 8255 female respondents (Response rate = 82.1%)
- 253 Indigenous respondents (Response rate = 70.1%)

West Moreton Statistical Division

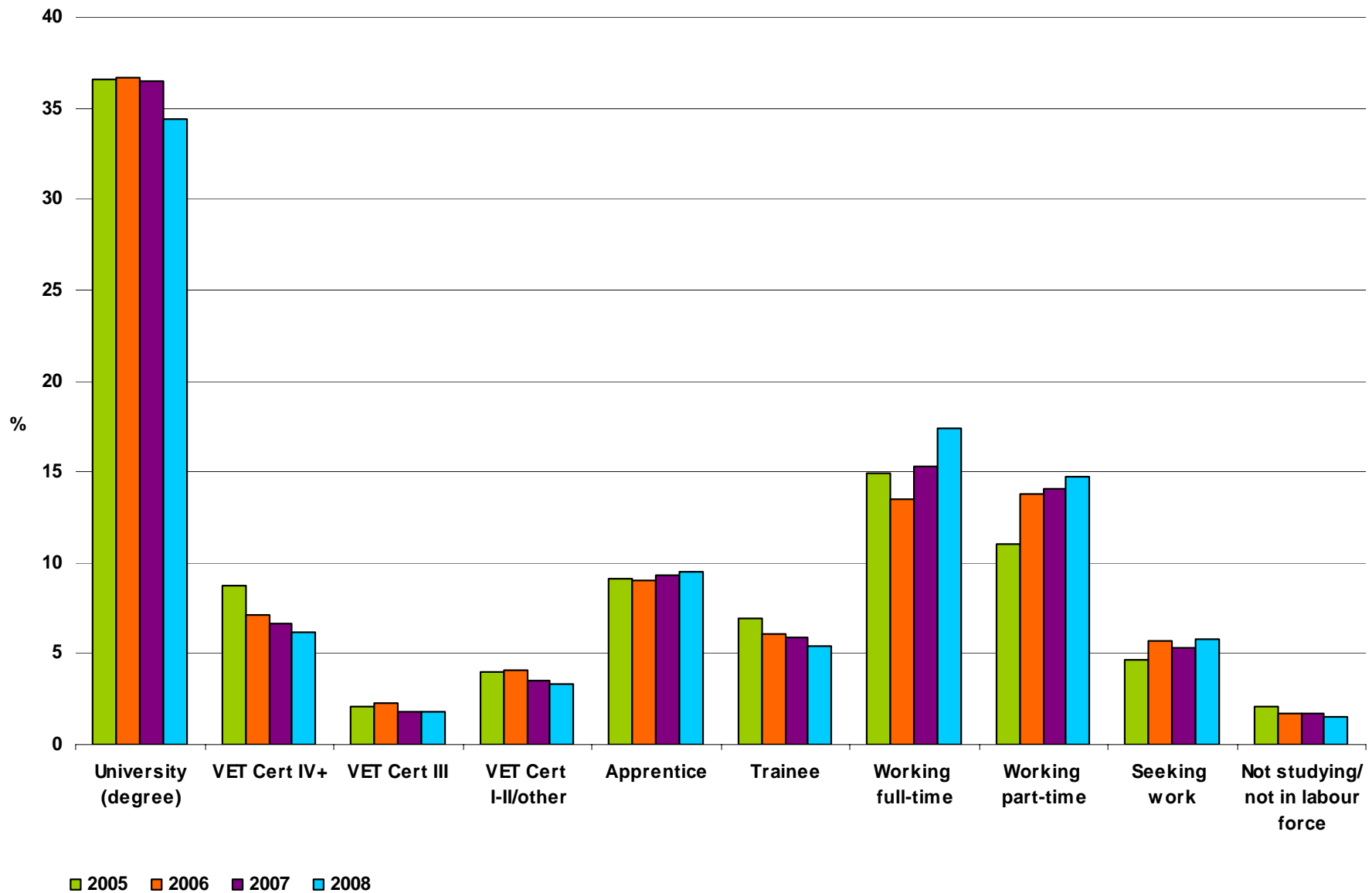
- 558 respondents (Response rate = 83.5%)

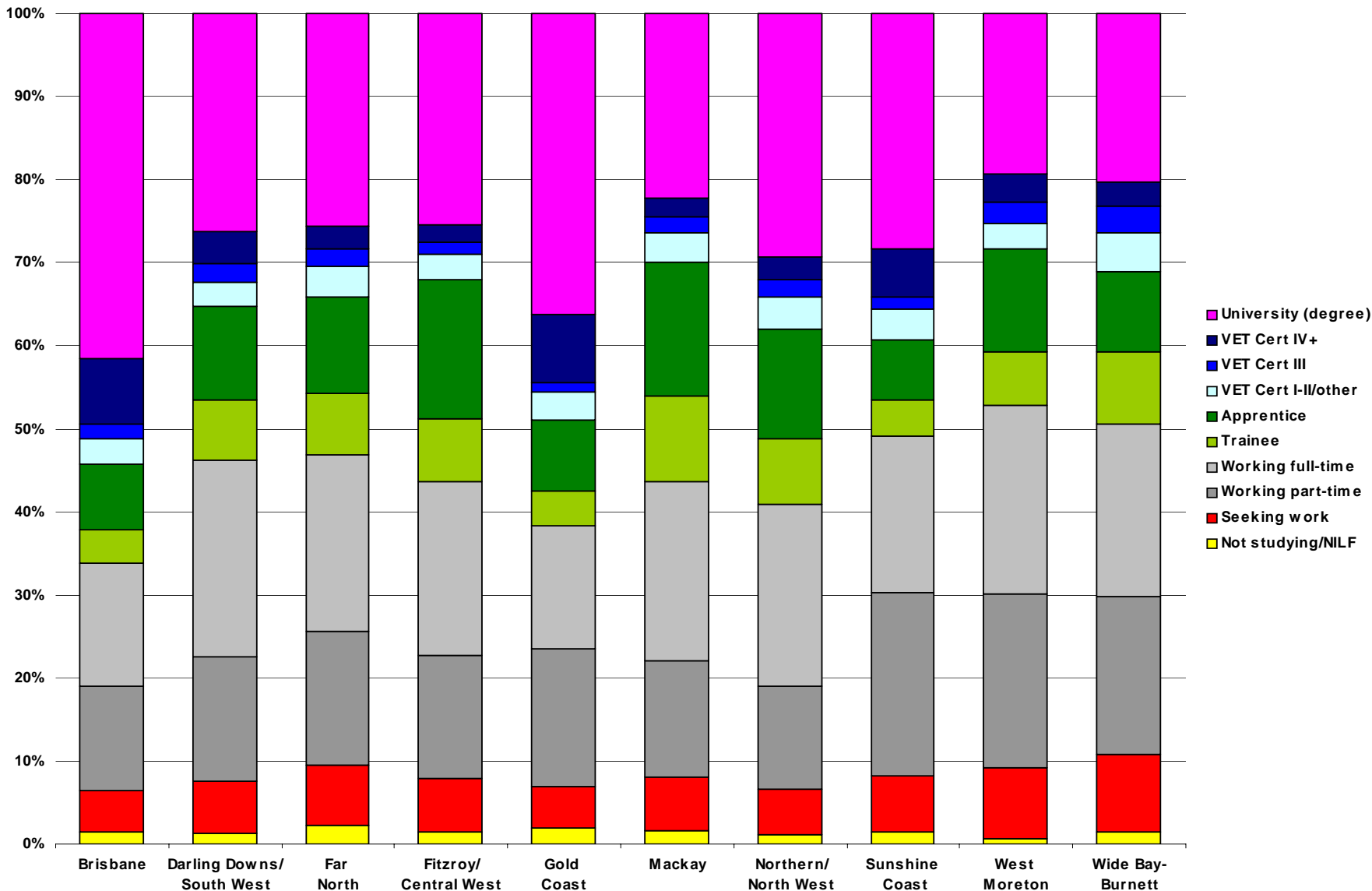

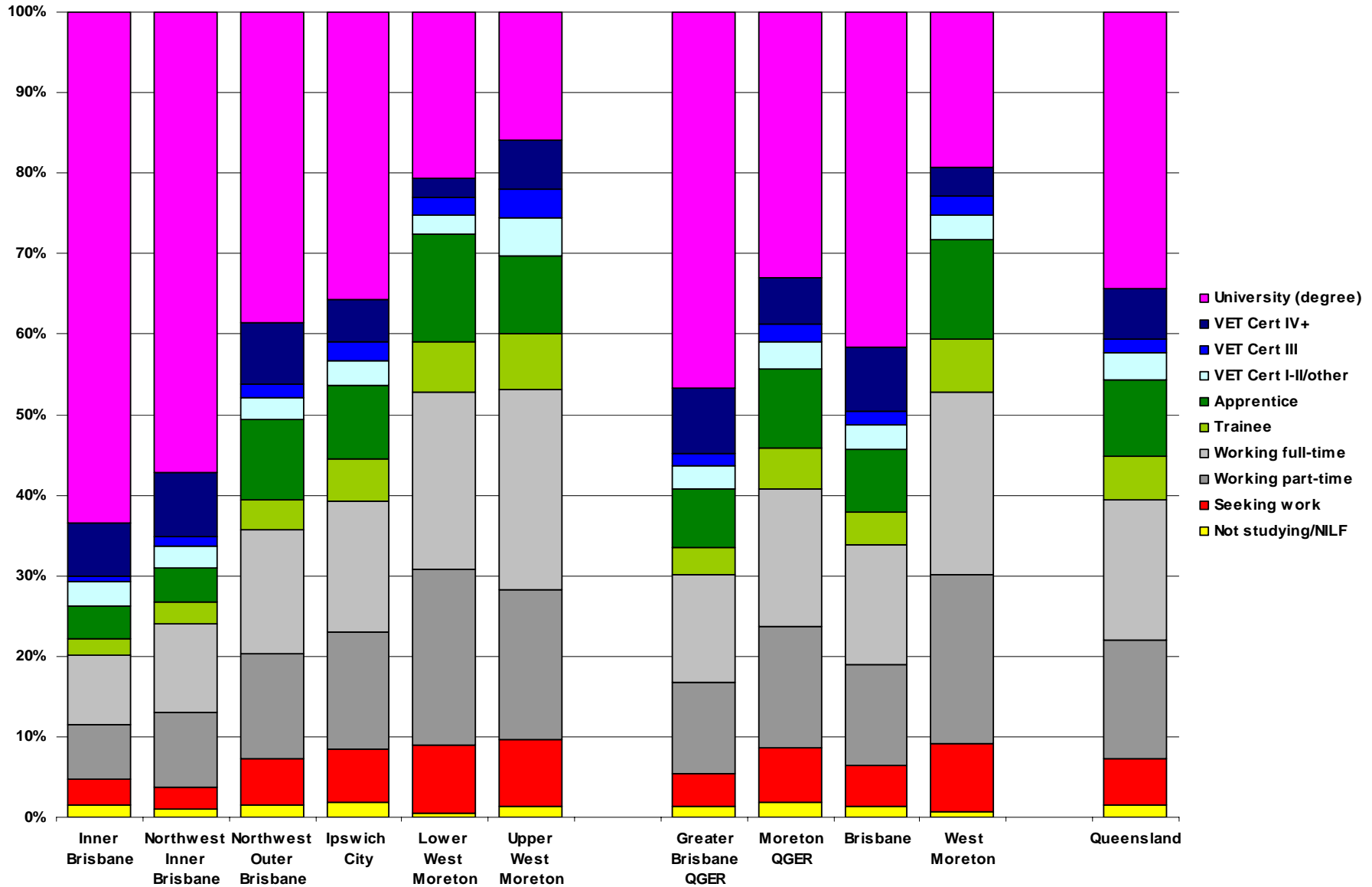
Main destinations, Queensland 2005–08



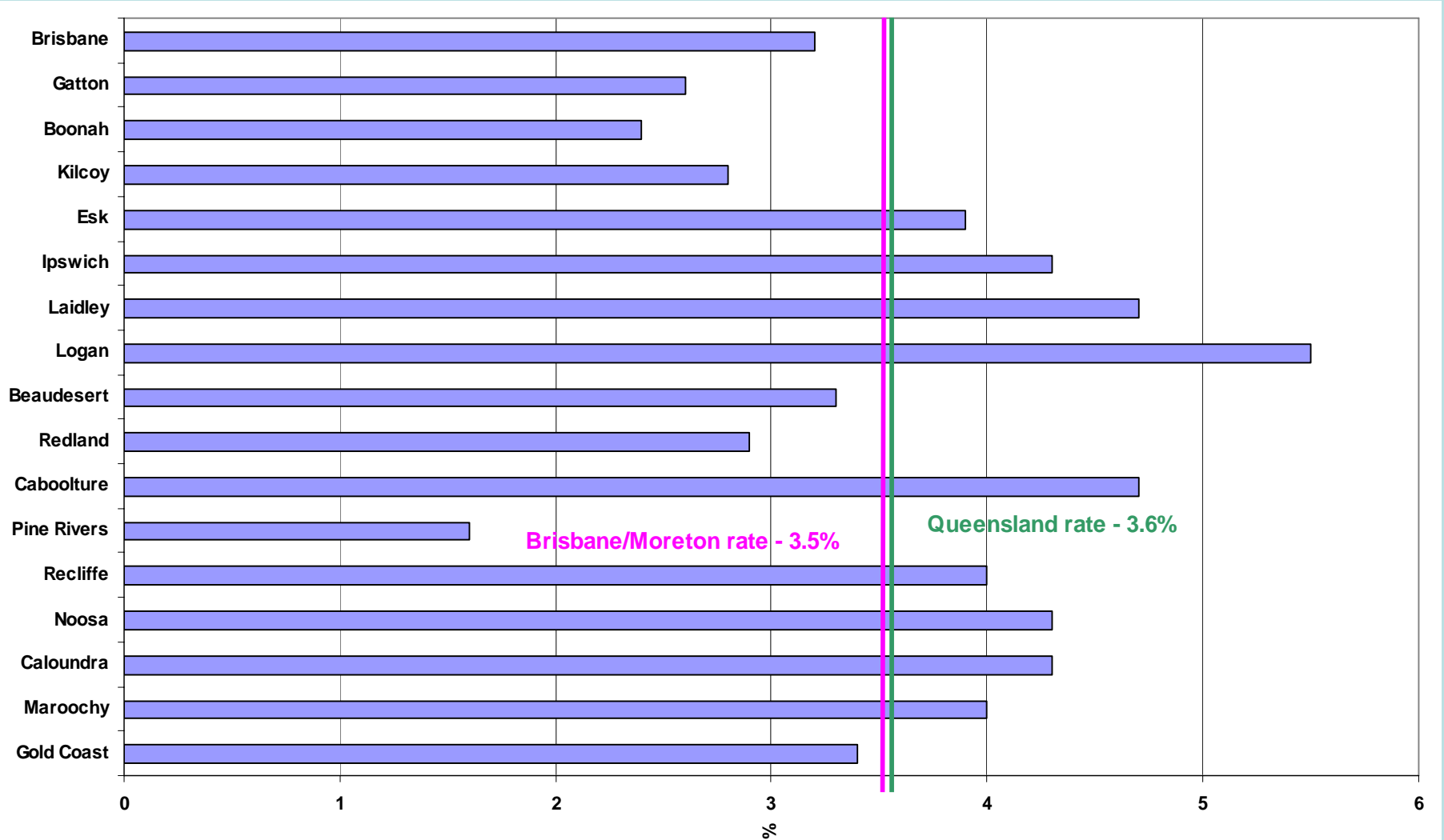
Main destinations by Queensland region, 2008



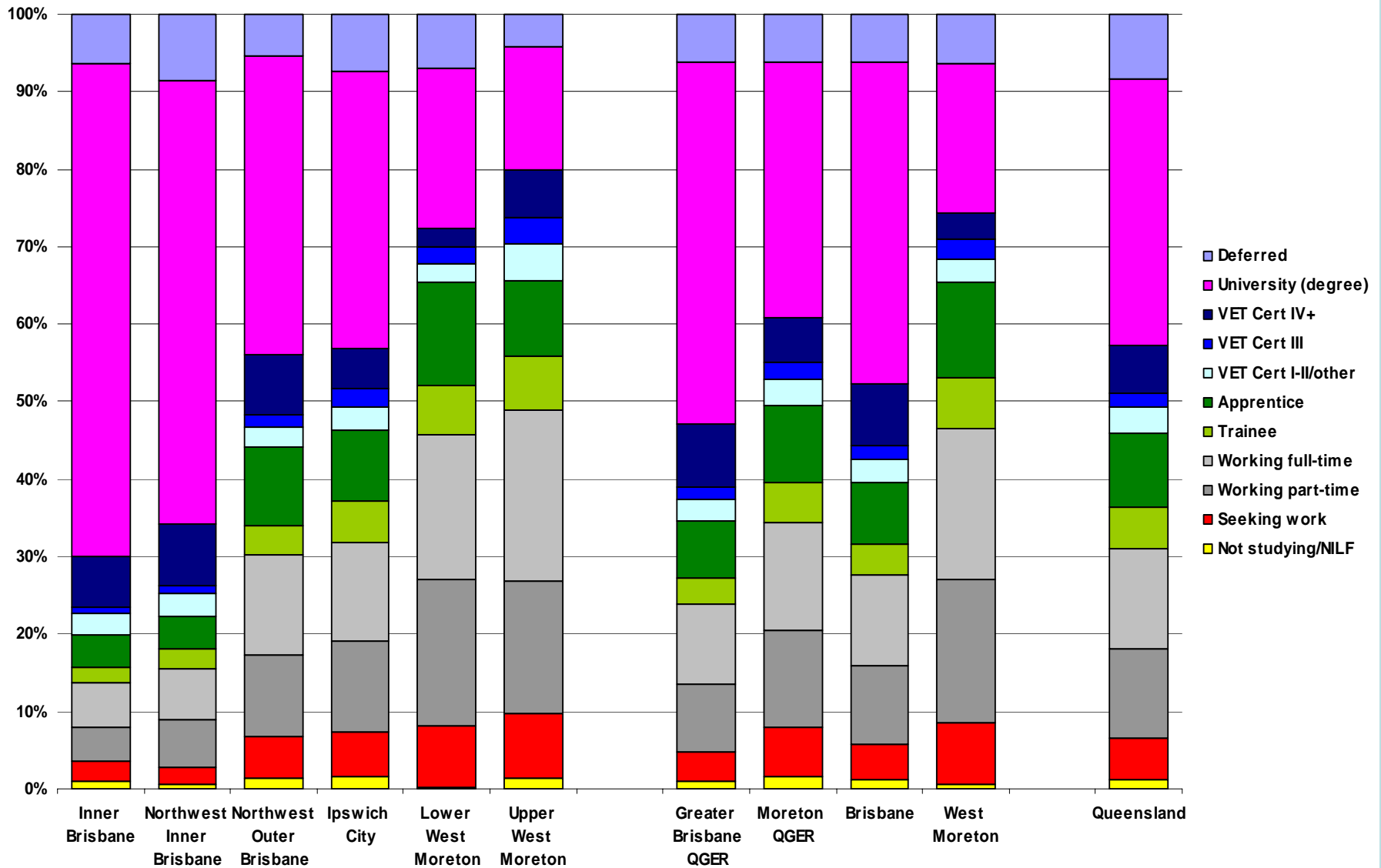

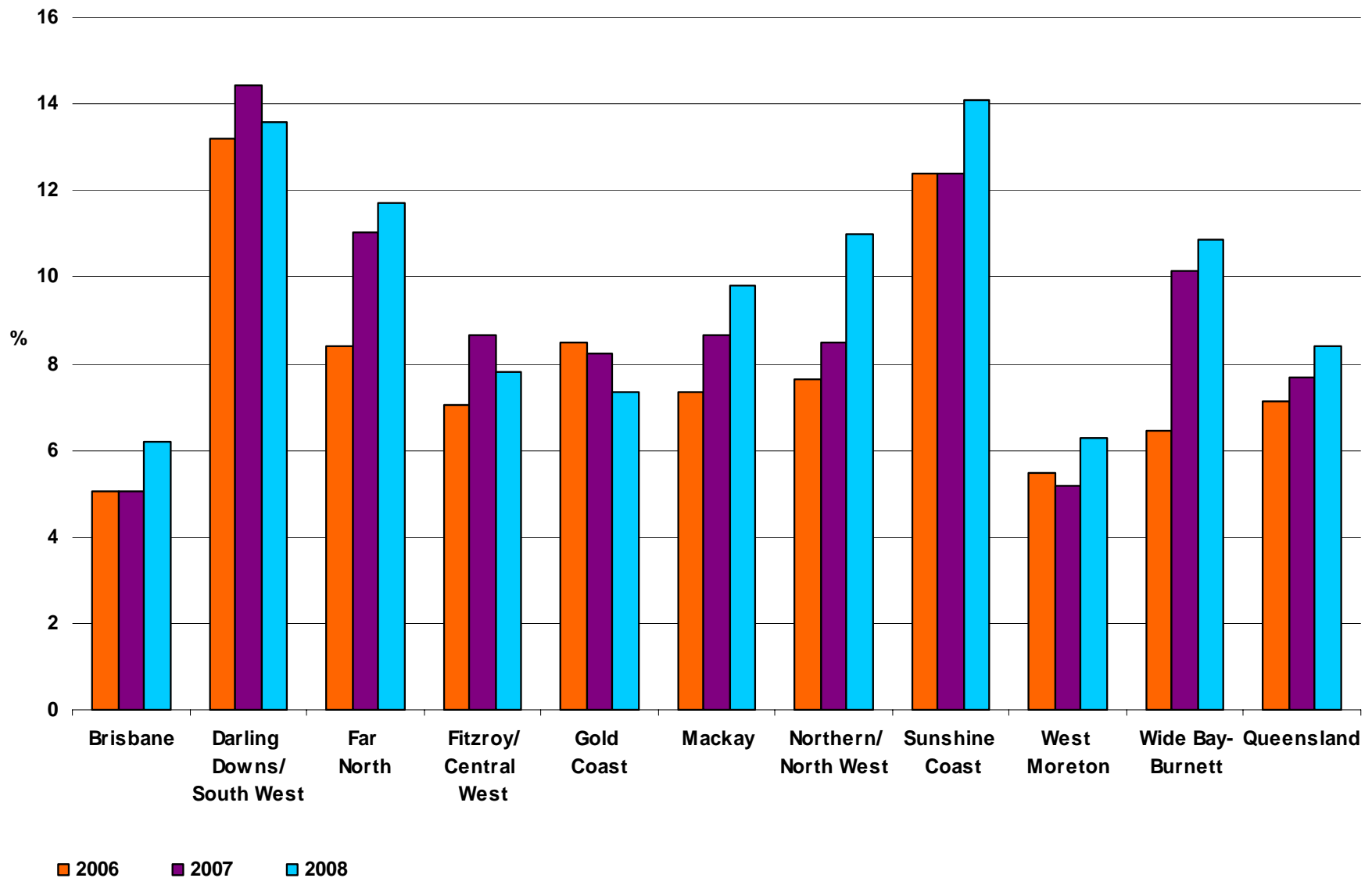
Unemployment rates, metropolitan area 2008 March quarter



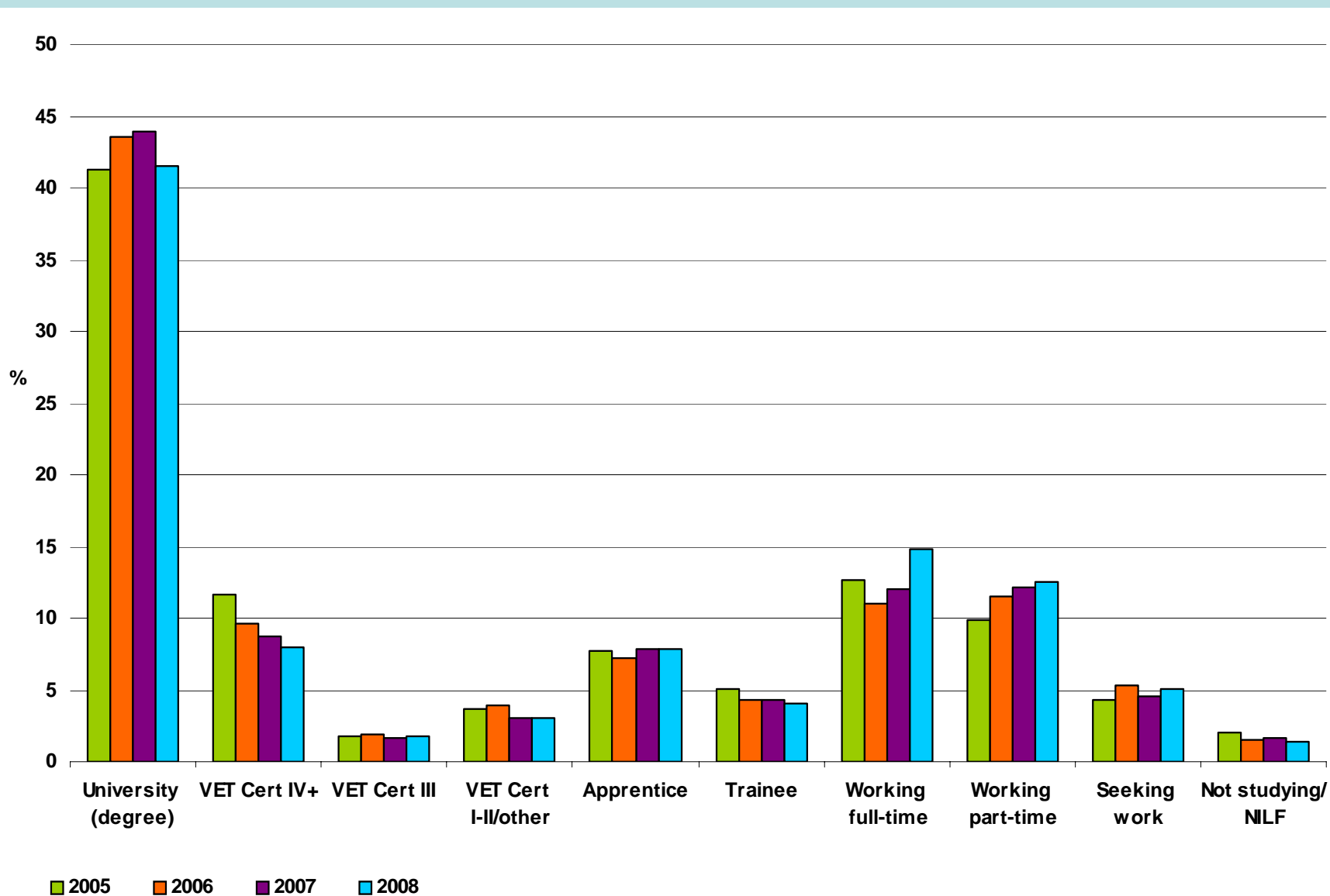

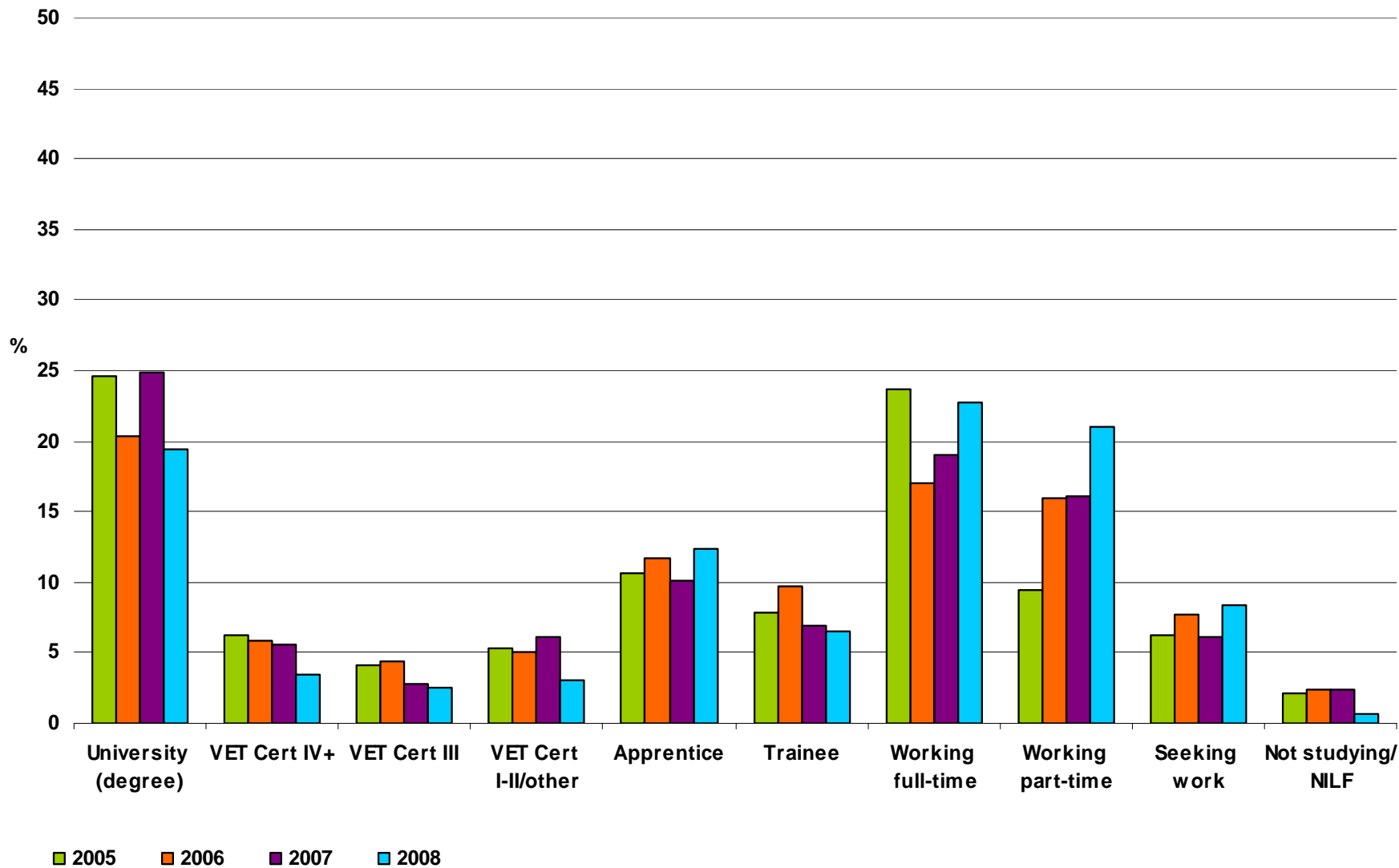
Deferrals by Queensland region, 2006–08



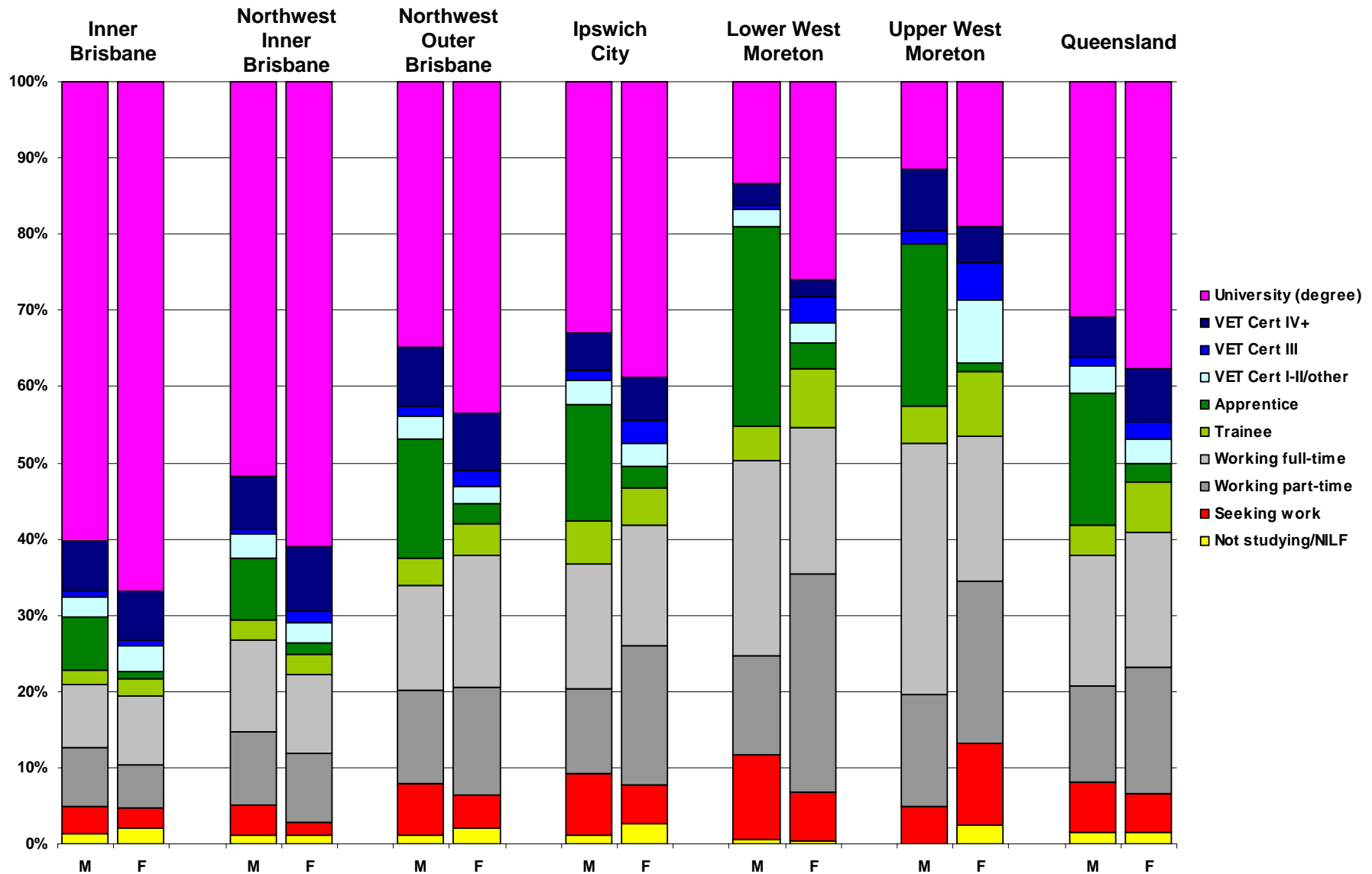

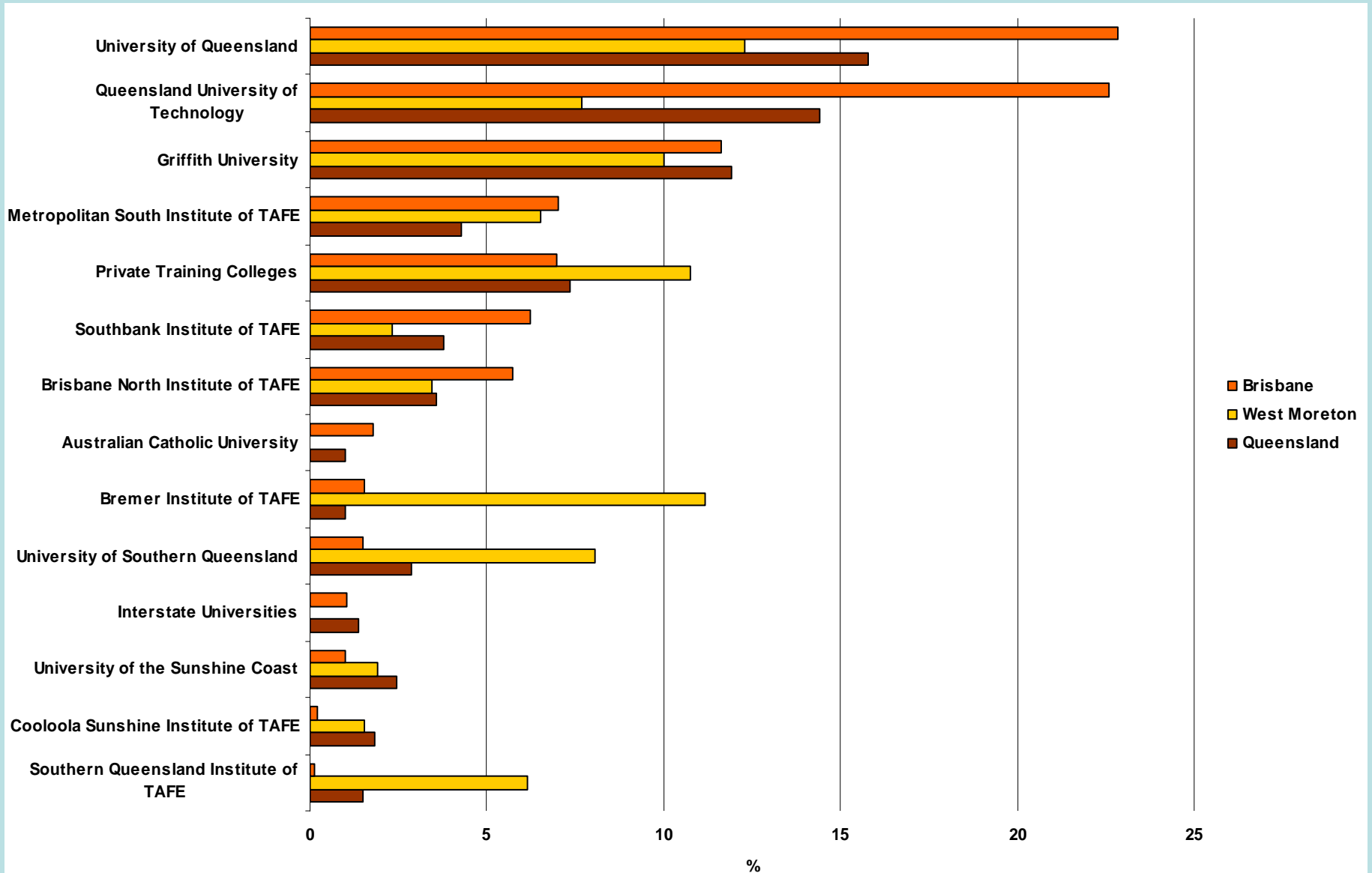


Main destinations by sex, Brisbane West 2008

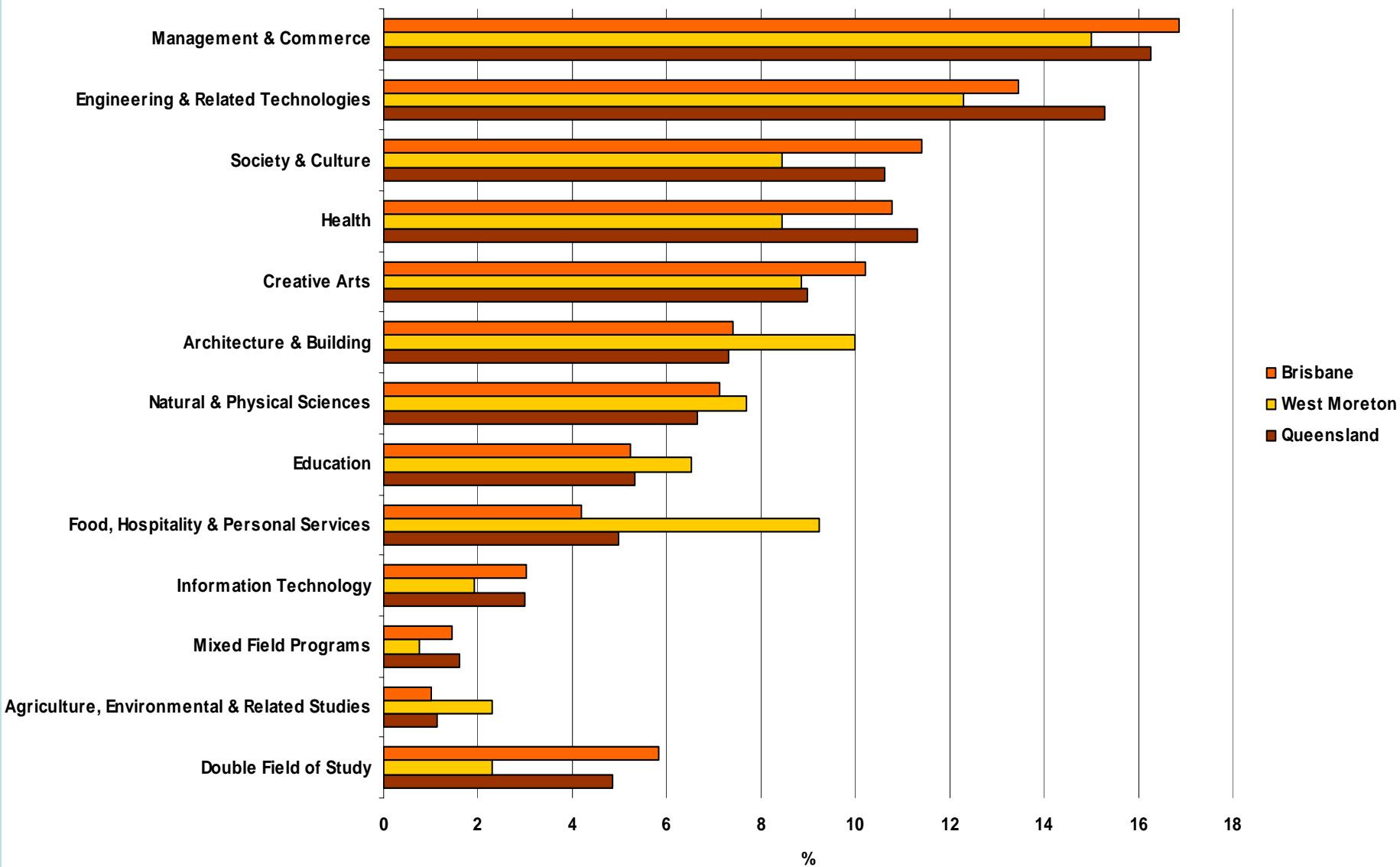

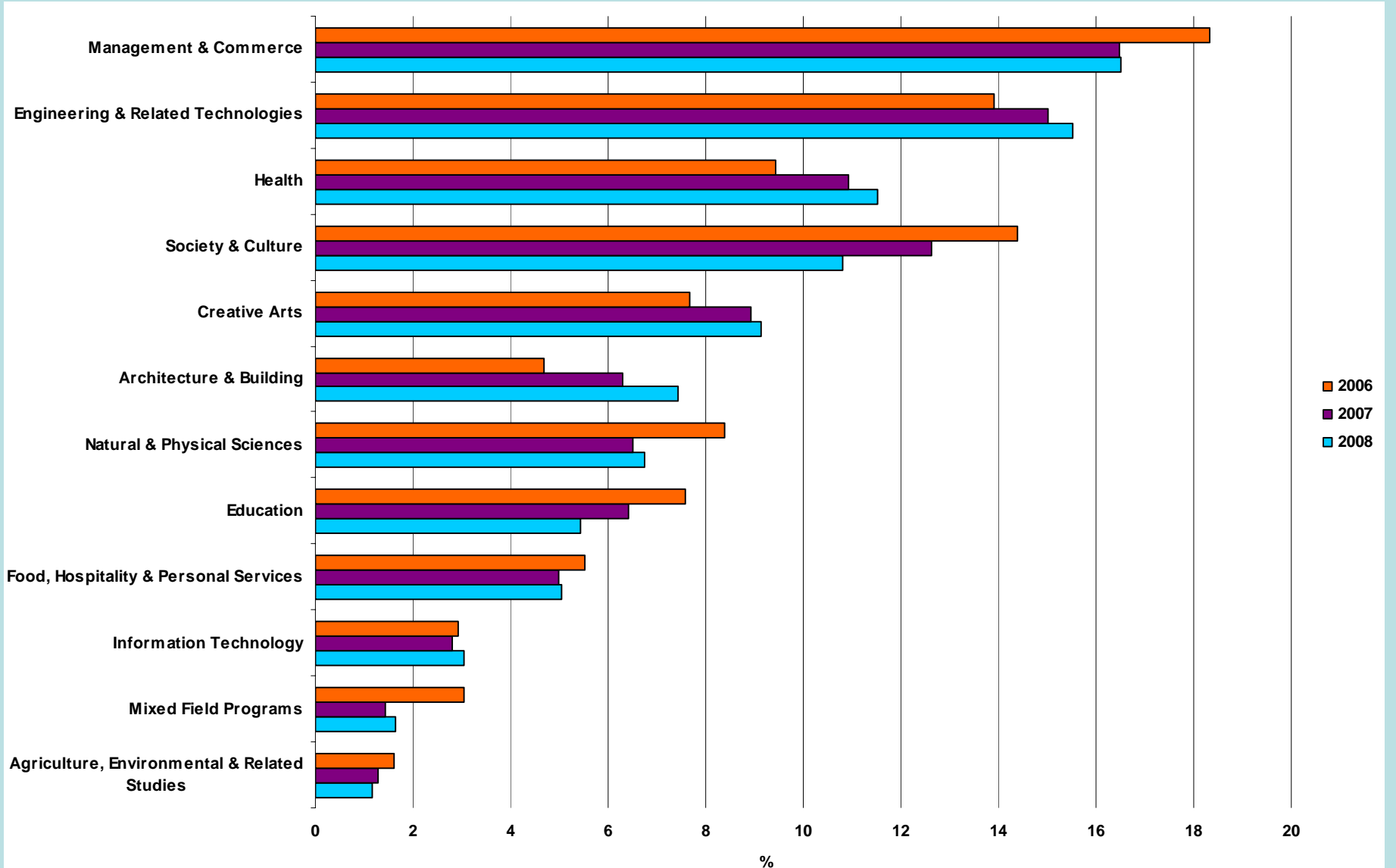
Main post-school institutions by region, 2008



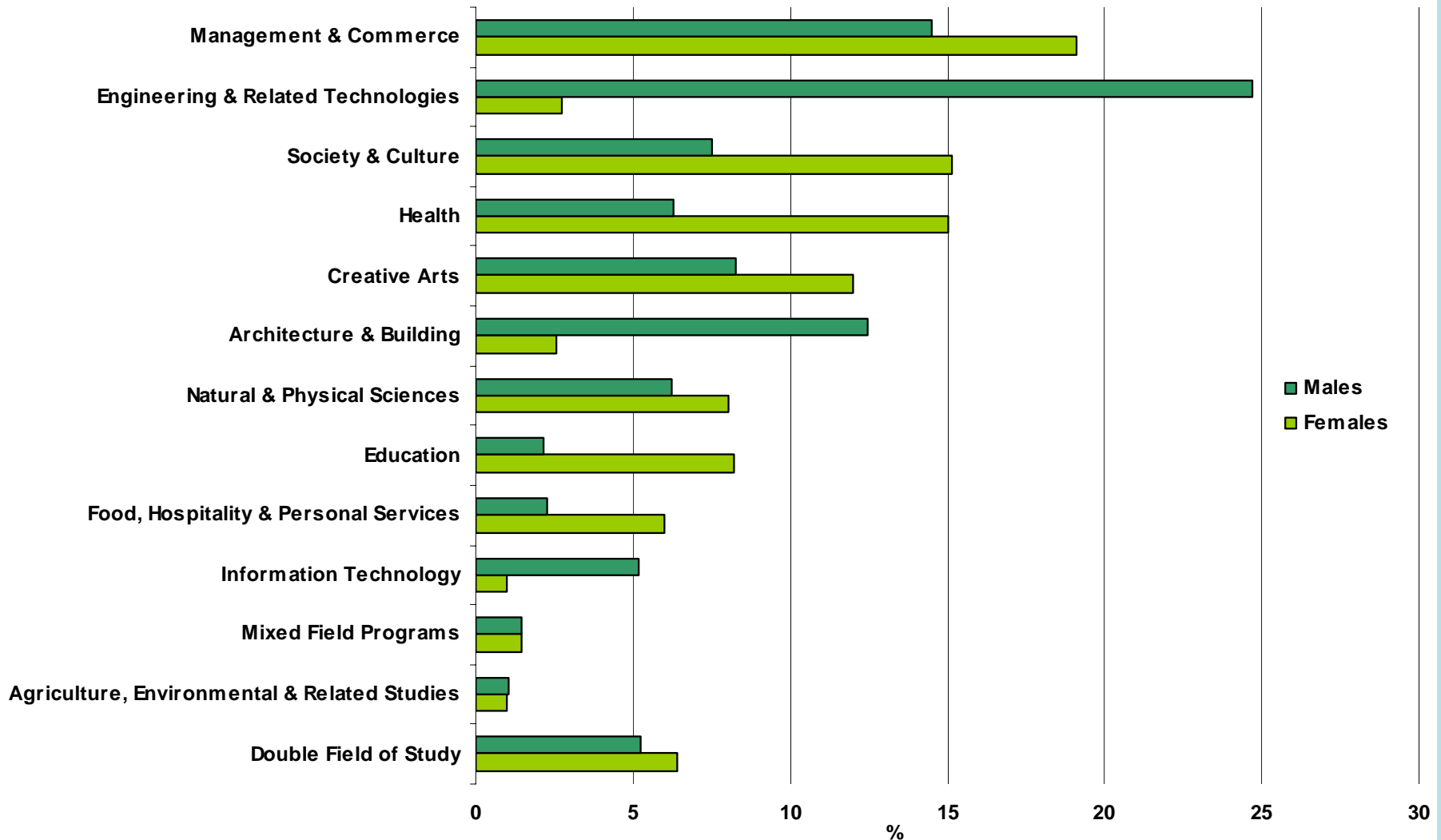
Main post-school field of study by region, 2008



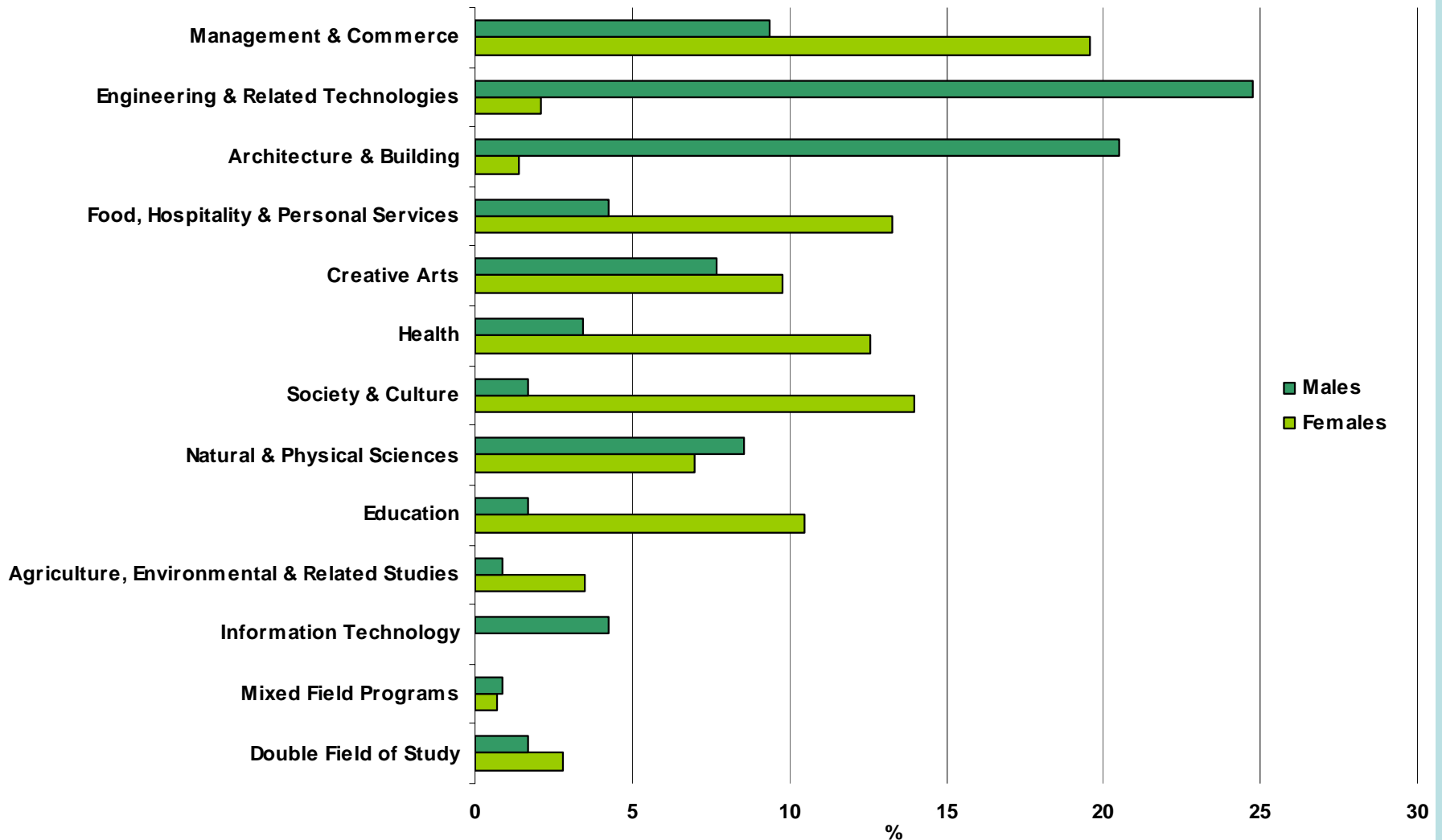
Main post-school field of study Queensland 2006–08



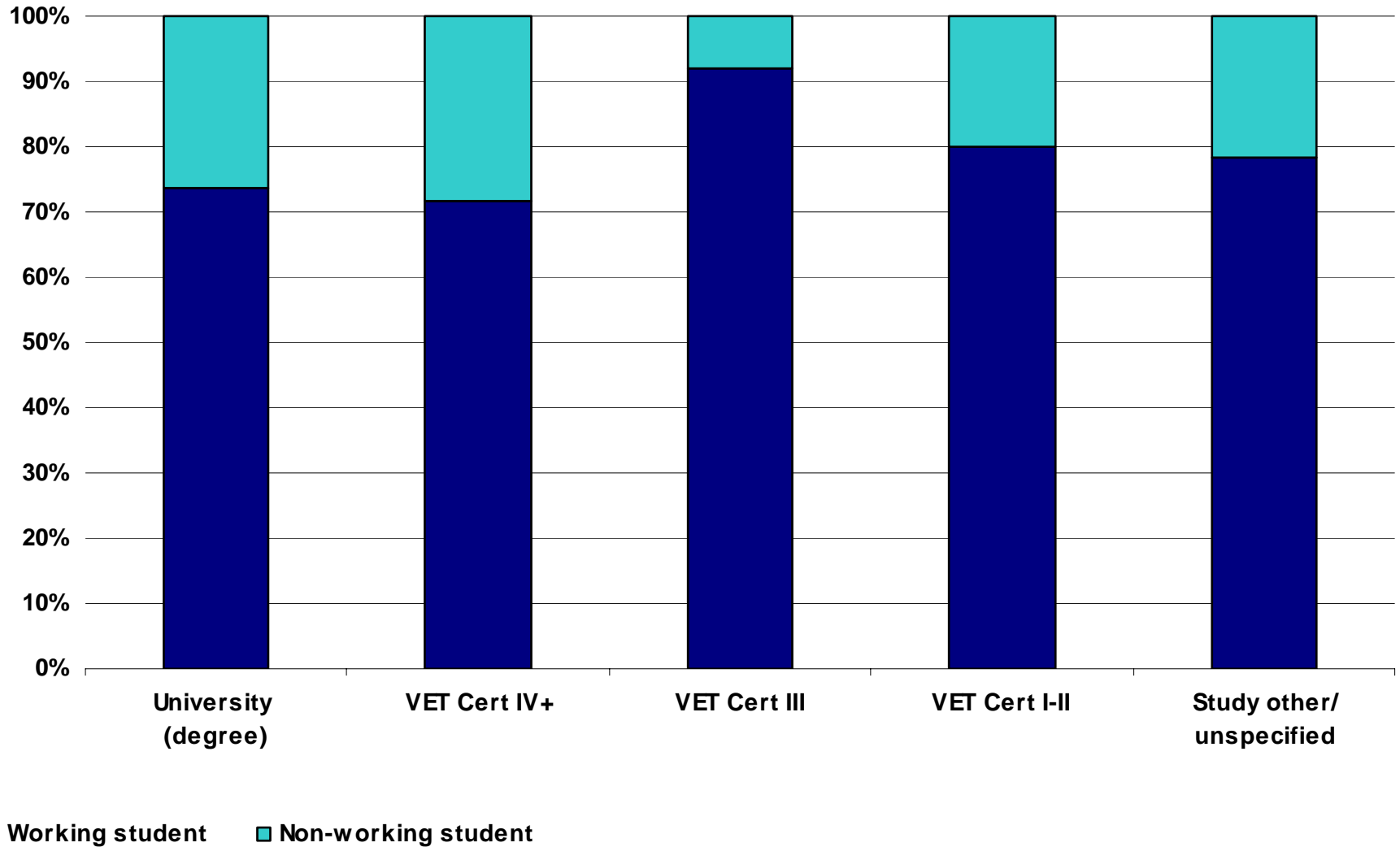
Post-school field of study, by sex, Brisbane Statistical Division 2008



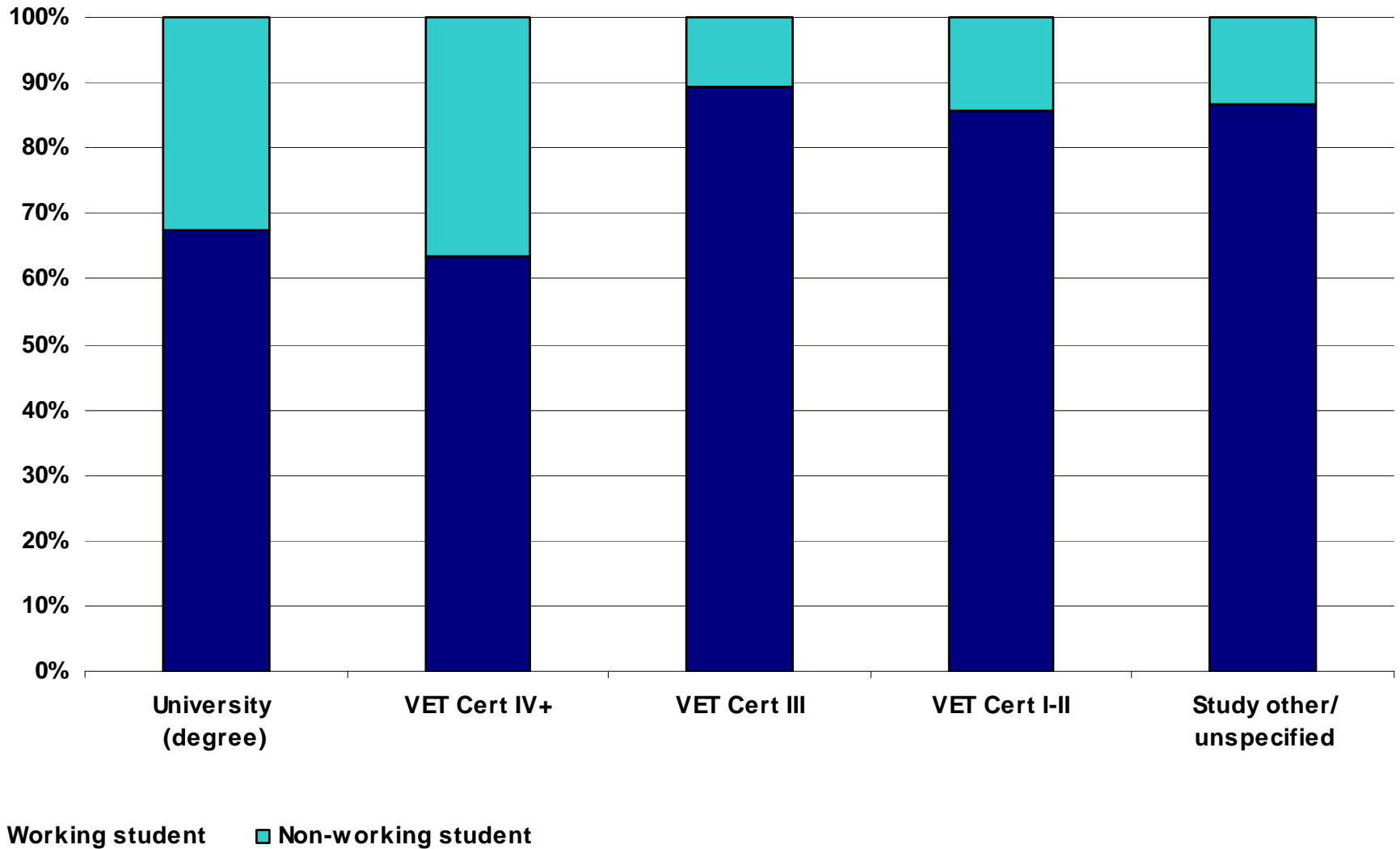
Post-school field of study, by sex, West Moreton Statistical Division 2008



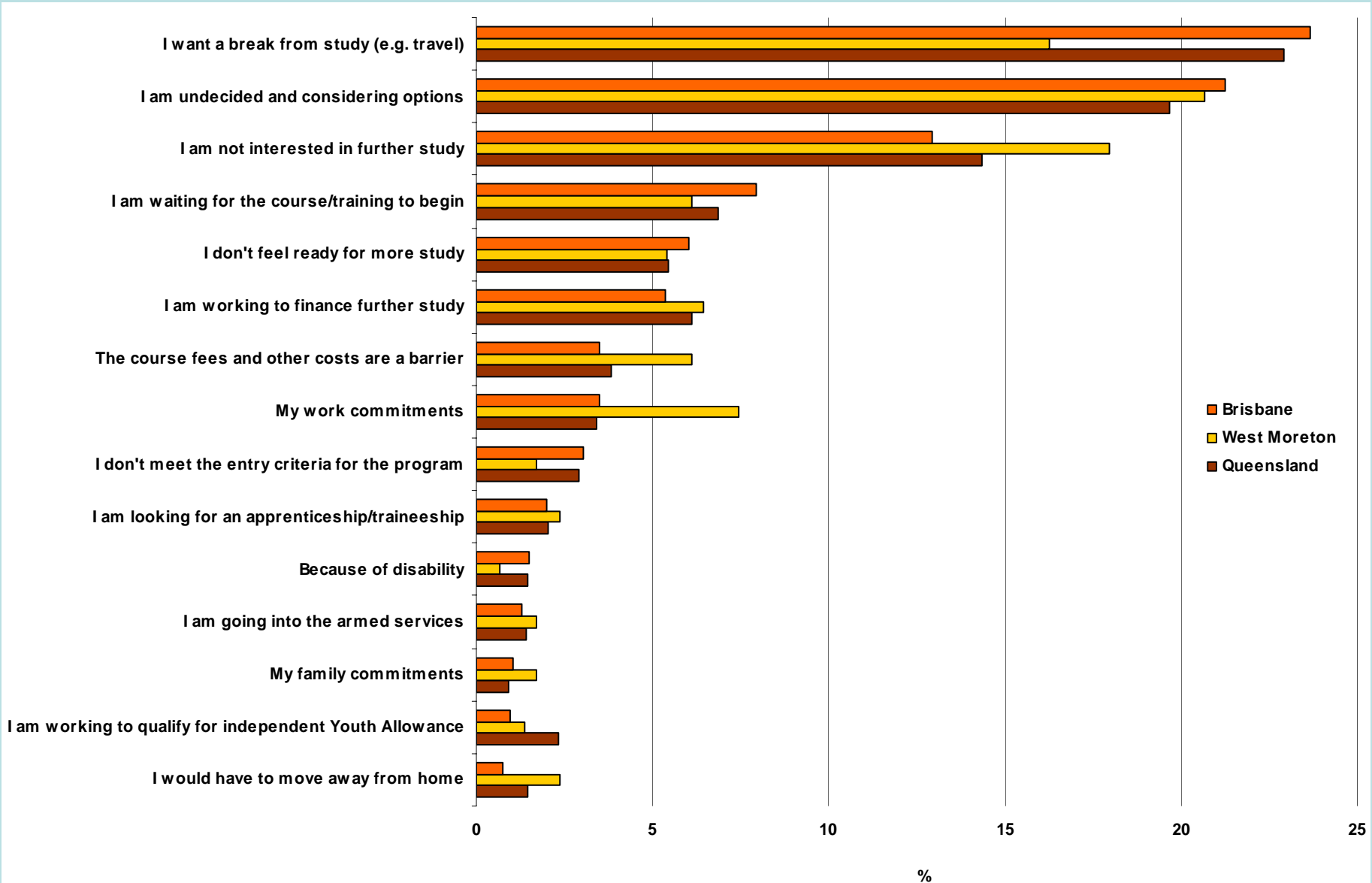
Proportion of students working by level of study, Brisbane Statistical Division 2008



Proportion of students working by level of study, West Moreton Statistical Division 2008

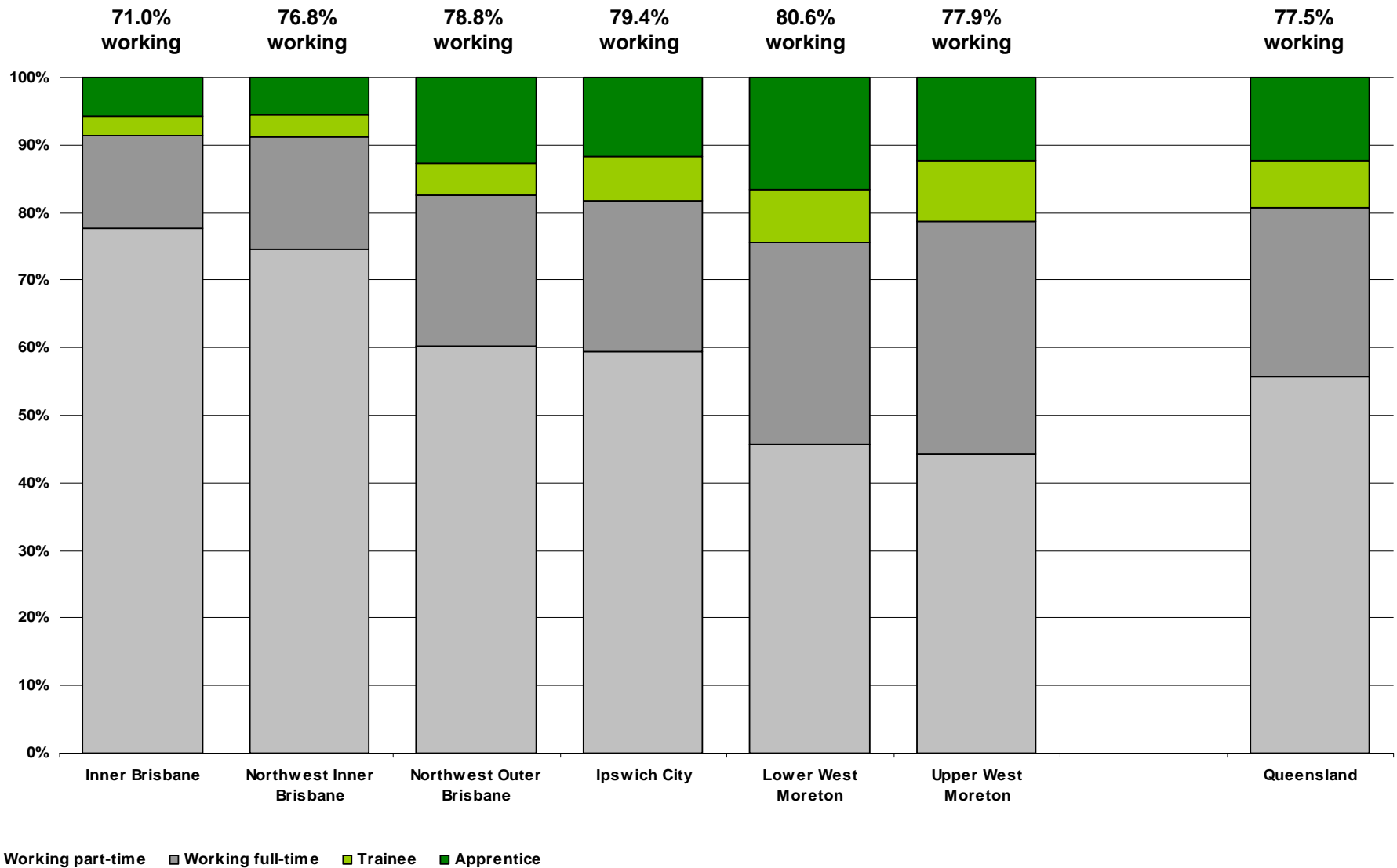

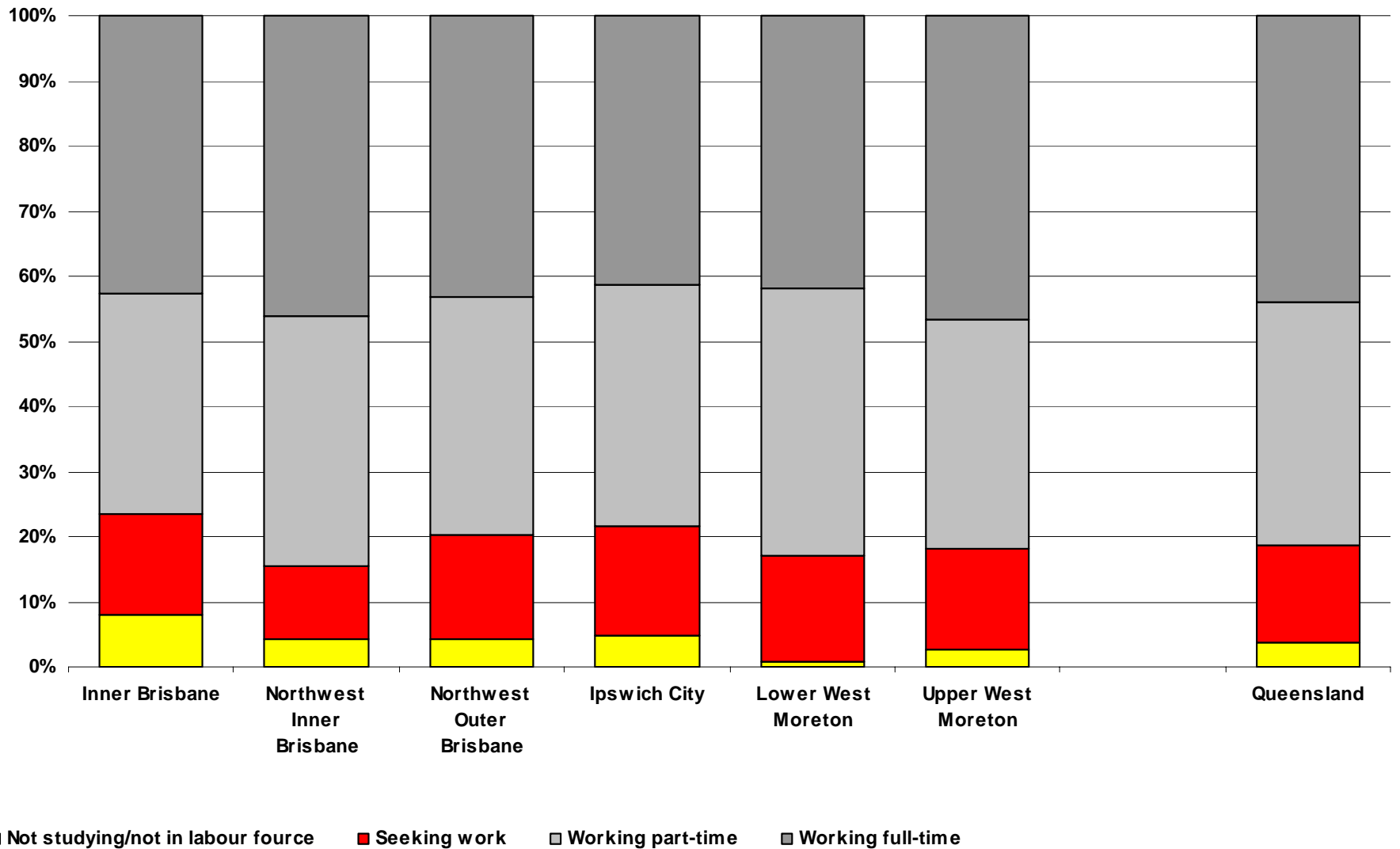

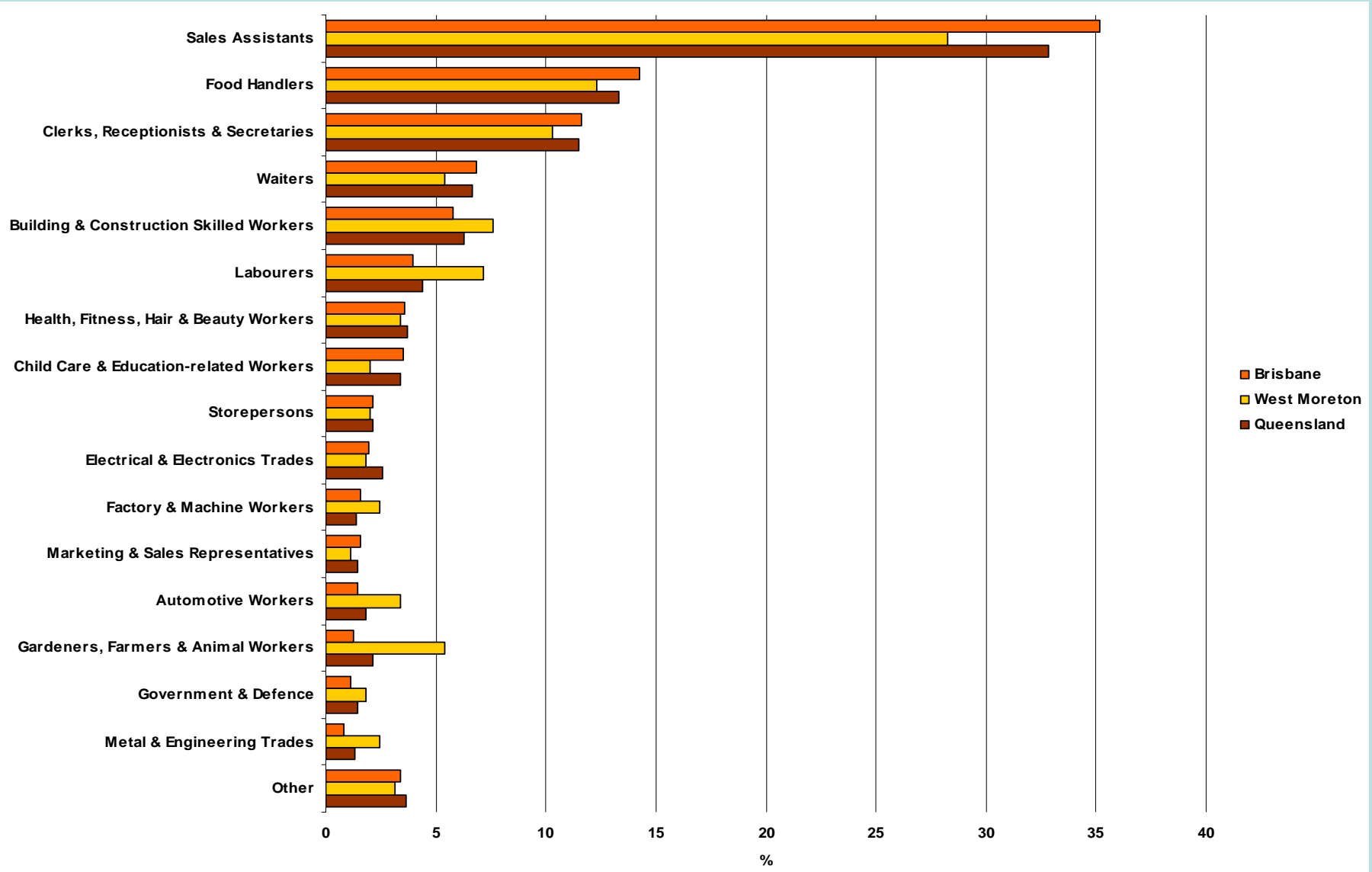
Work destinations of all Year 12 completers in employment, Brisbane West 2008



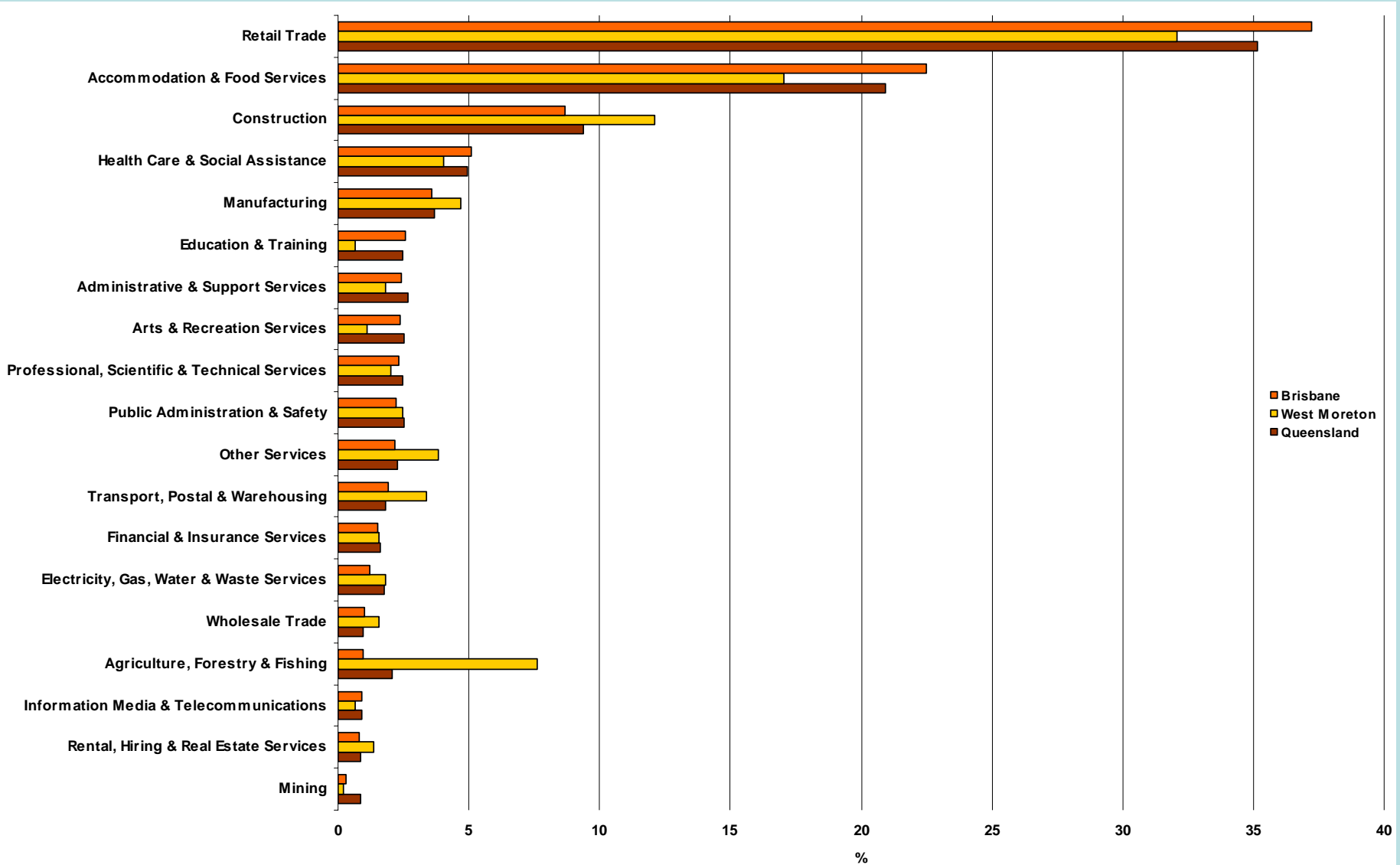
Main destinations of Year 12 completers not in education or training, Brisbane West 2008



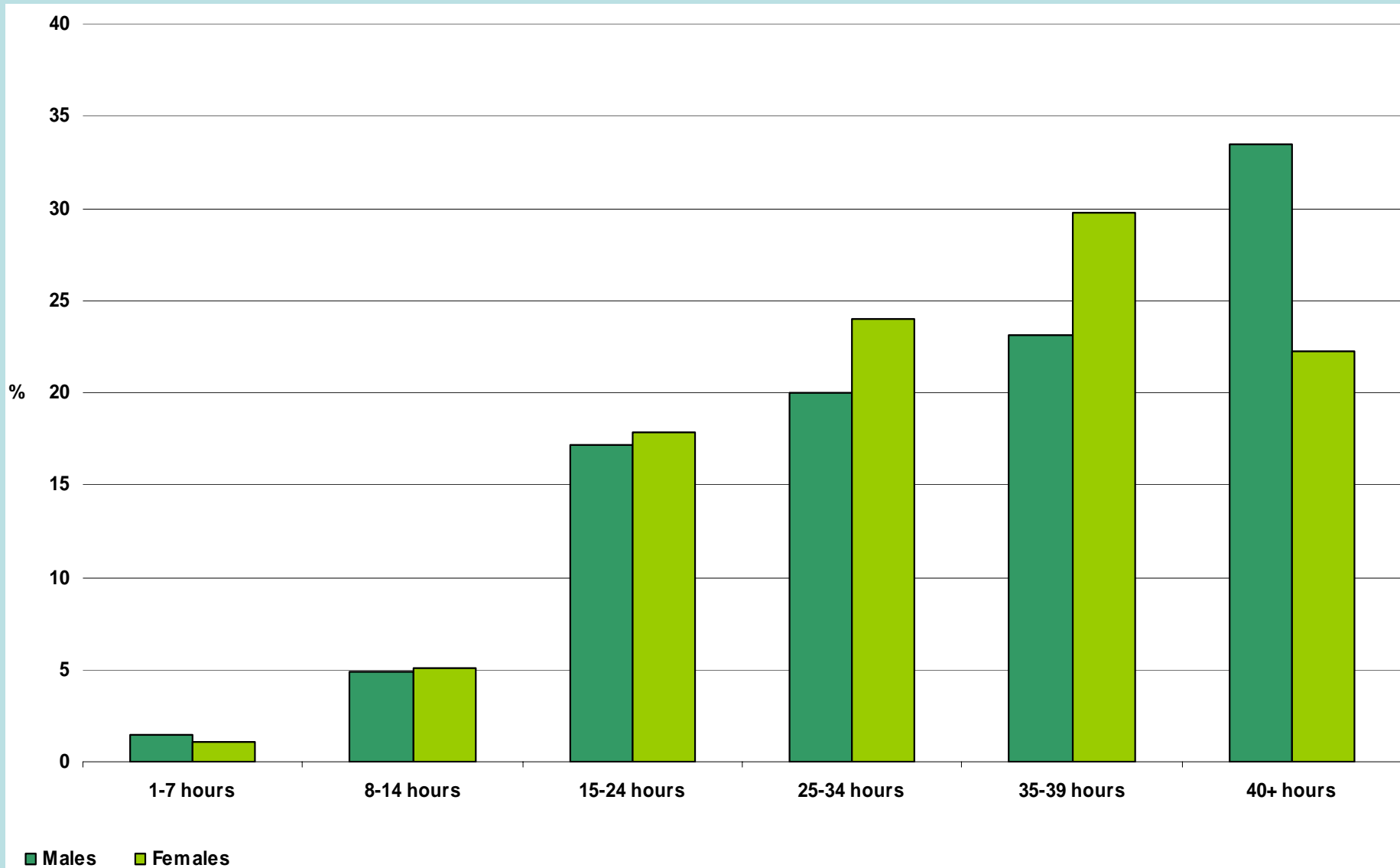
Occupations of Year 12 completers in employment by region, 2008



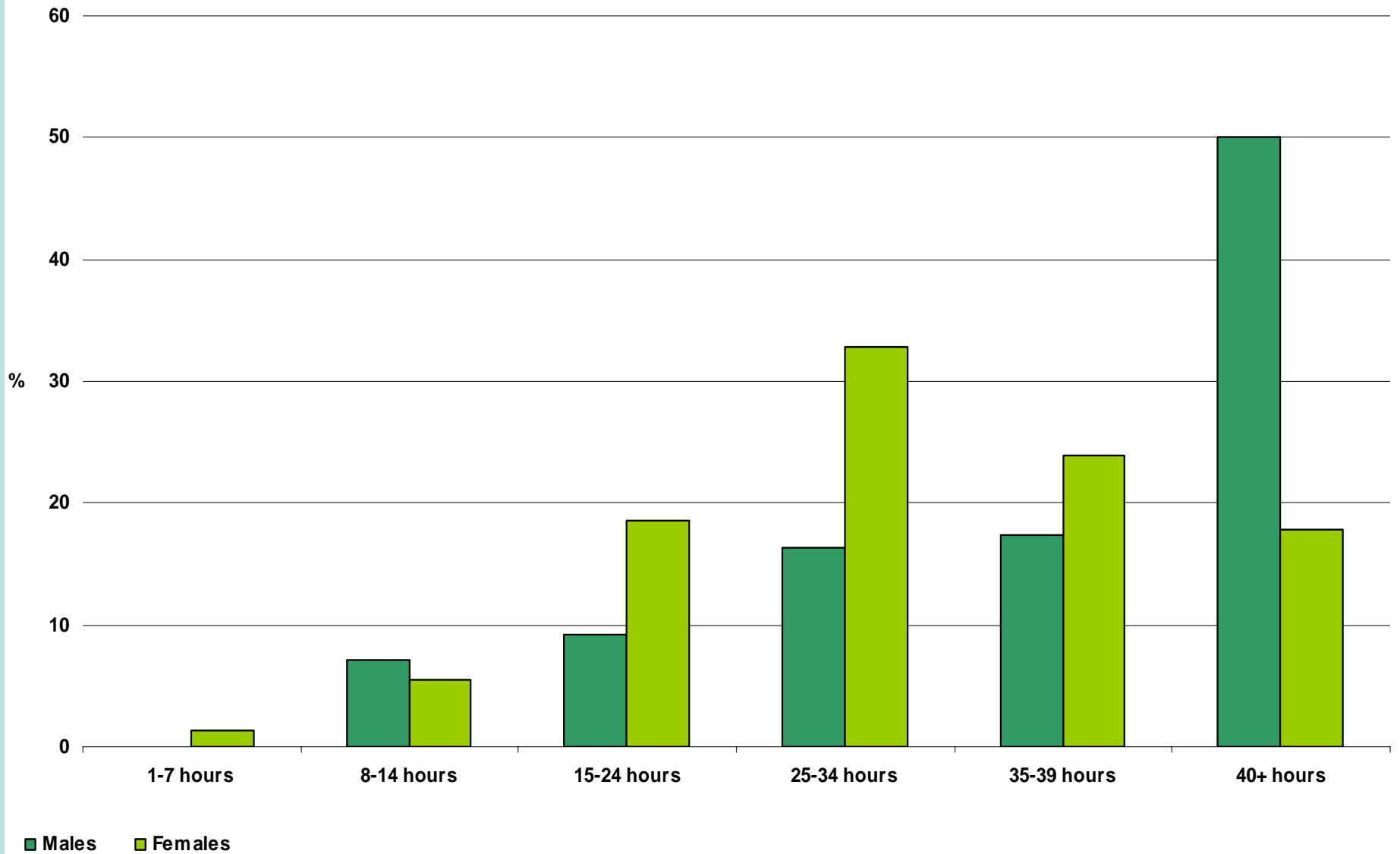
Industry area of Year 12 completers in employment by region, 2008



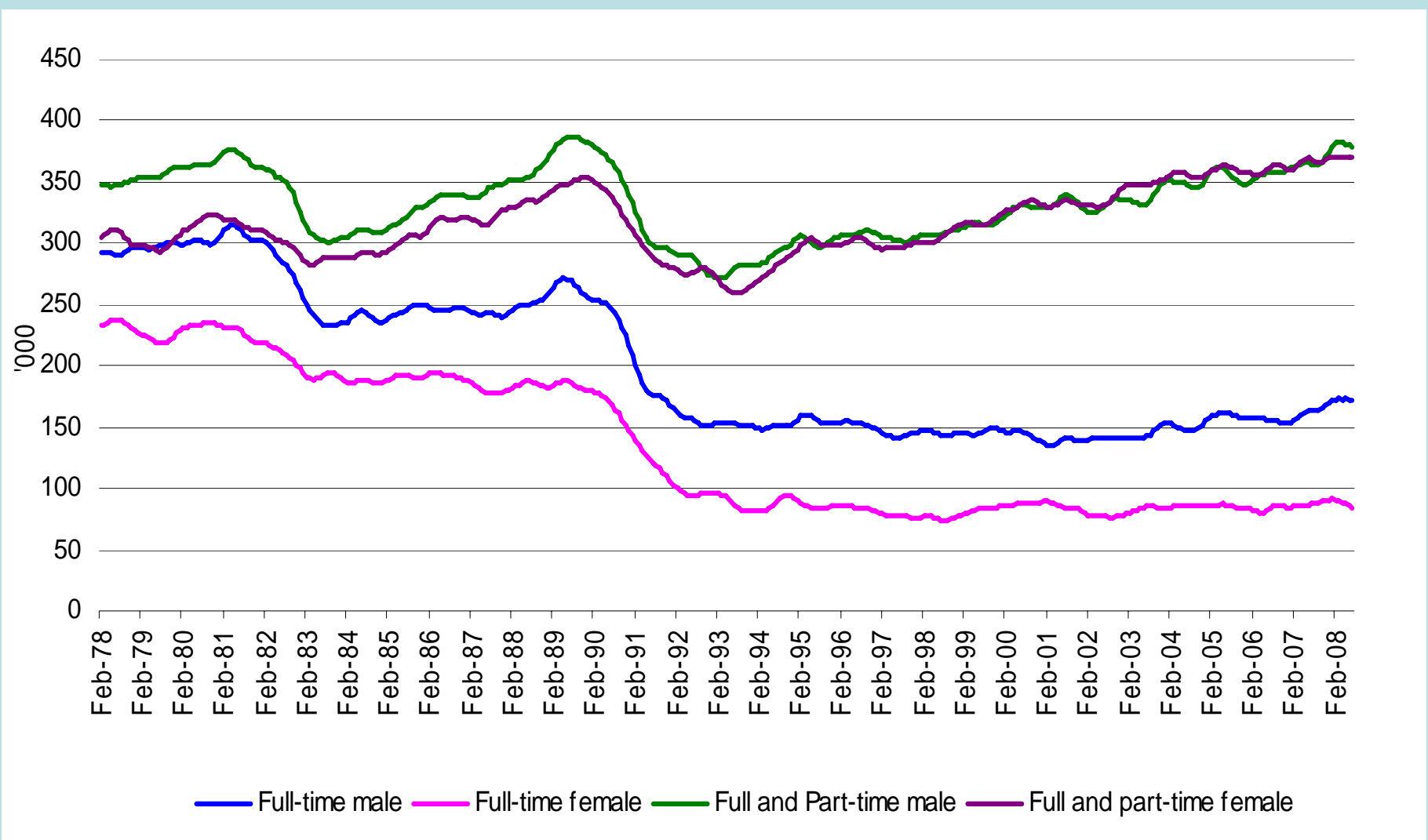
Hours worked by Year 12 completers not in education or training, Brisbane Statistical Division 2008



Hours worked by Year 12 completers not in education or training, West Moreton Statistical Division 2008



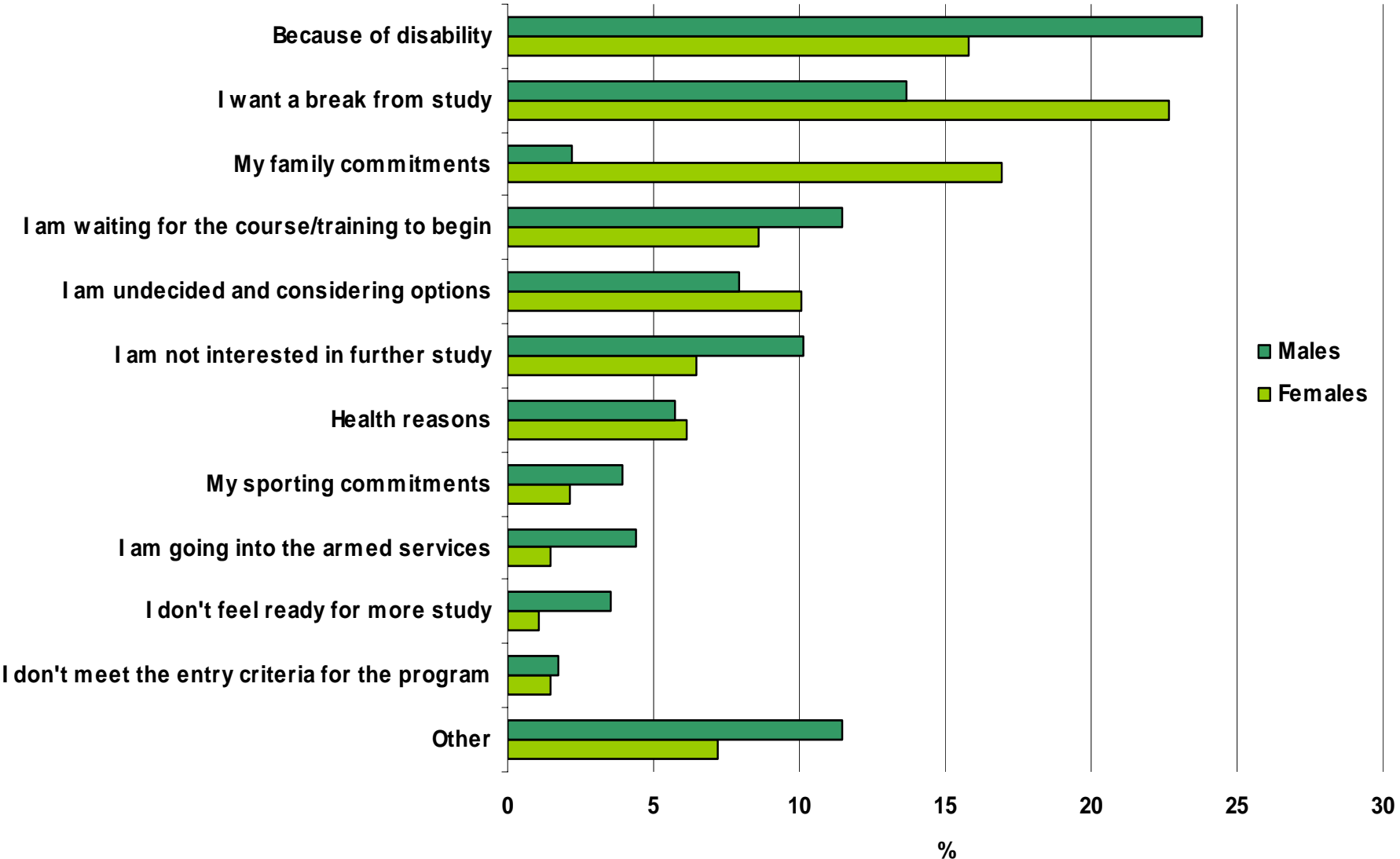
Employment, 15-19 year olds, Australia 1978–2008



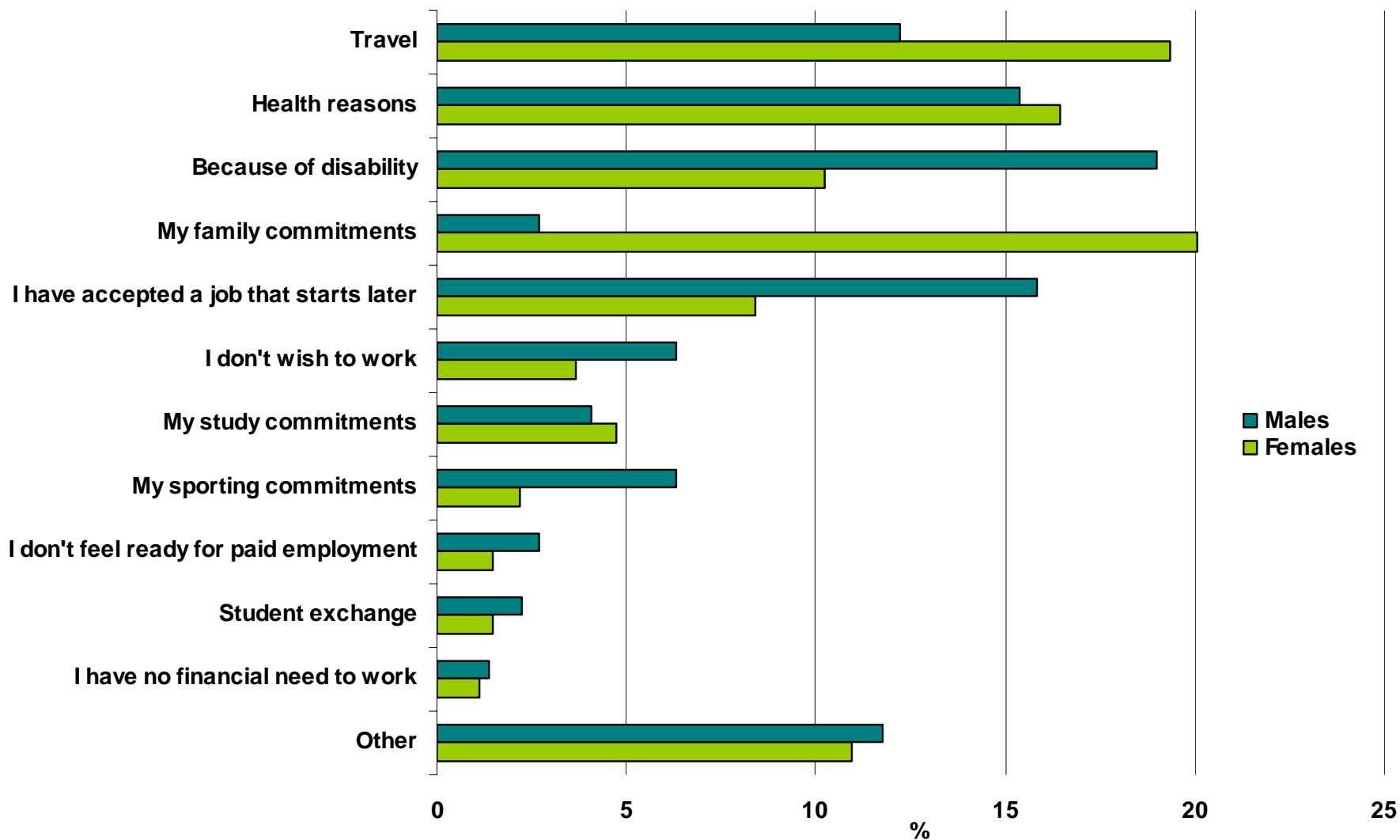

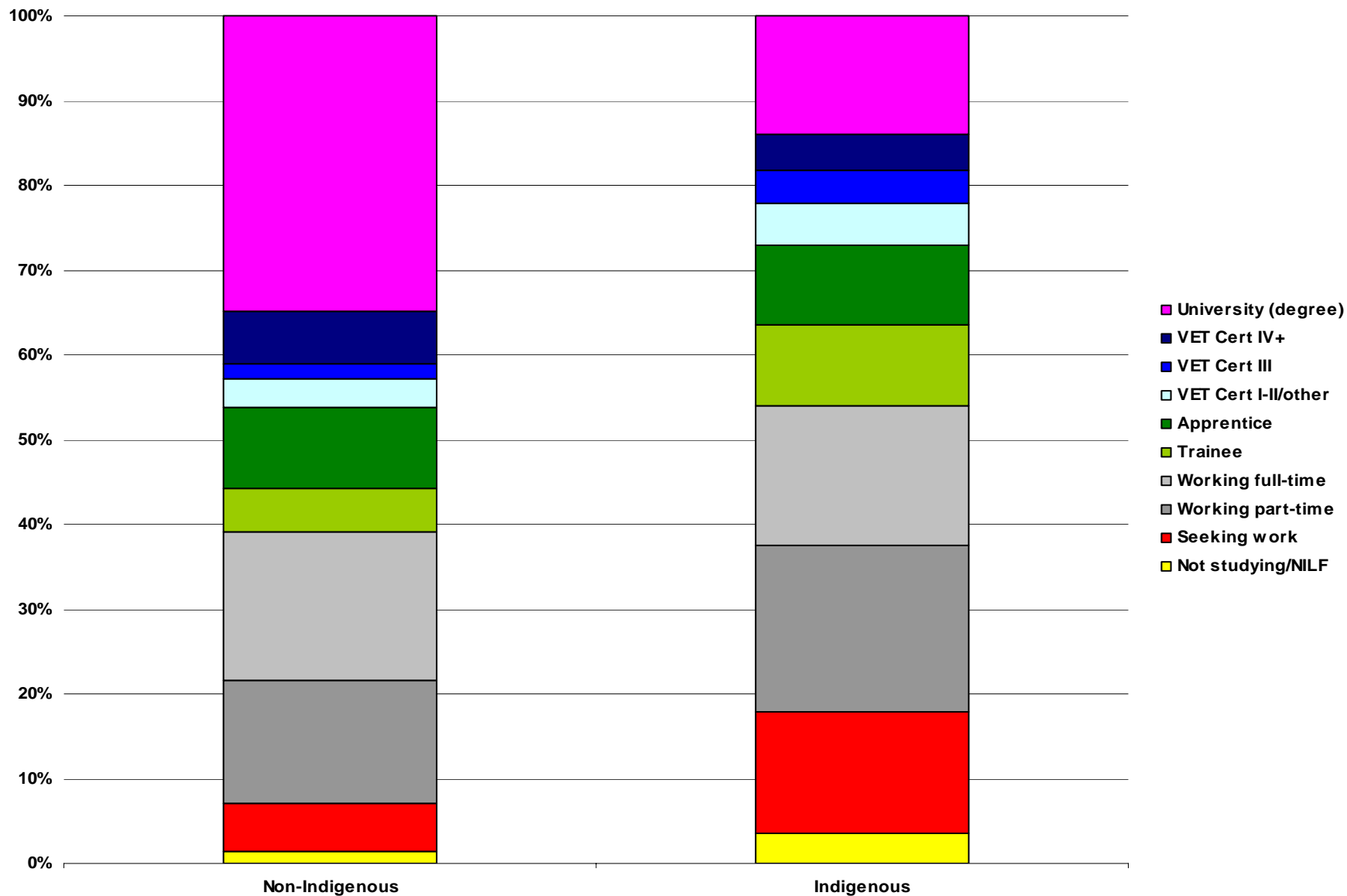


Main reason for not seeking work, Queensland 2008

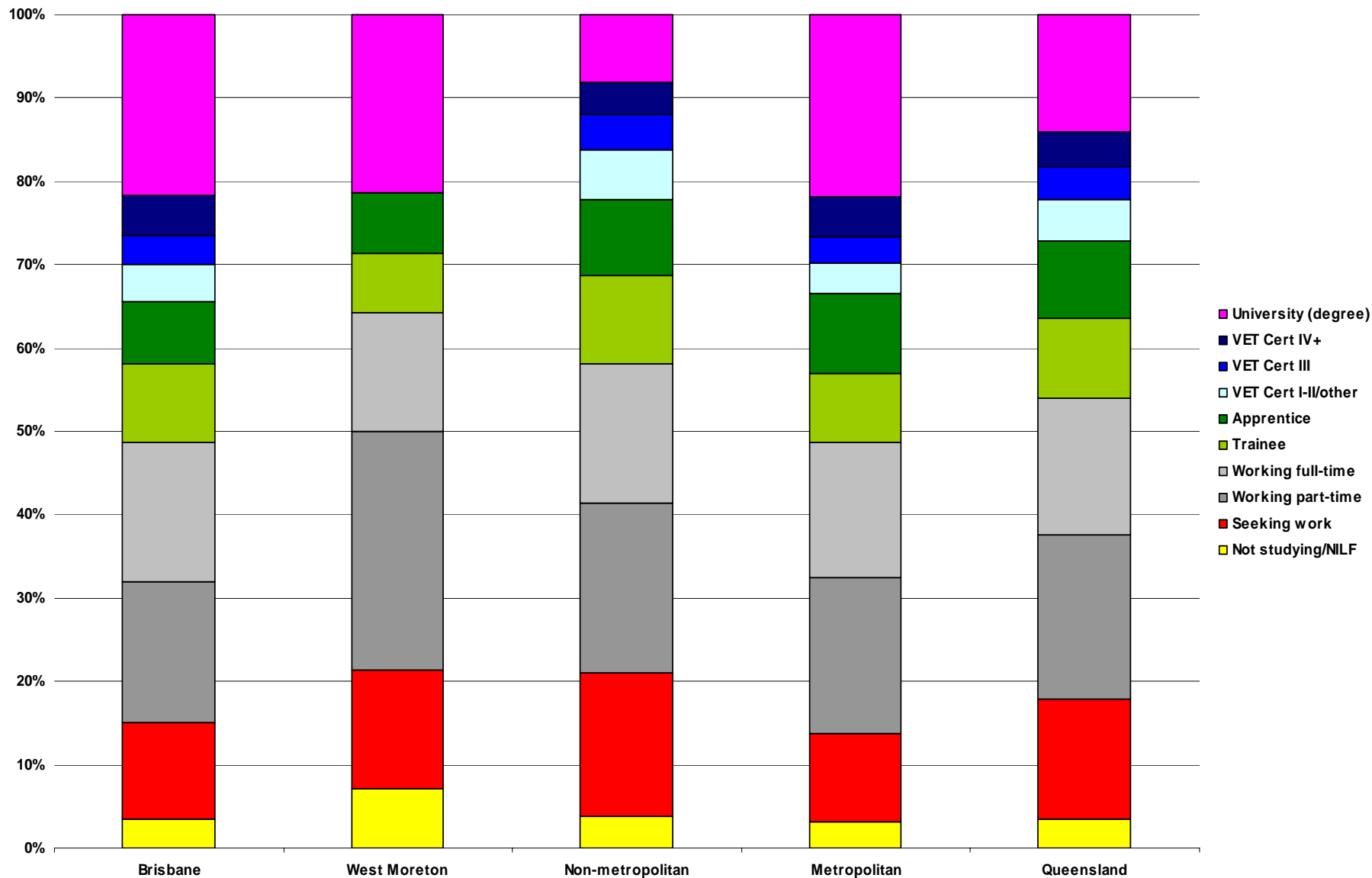

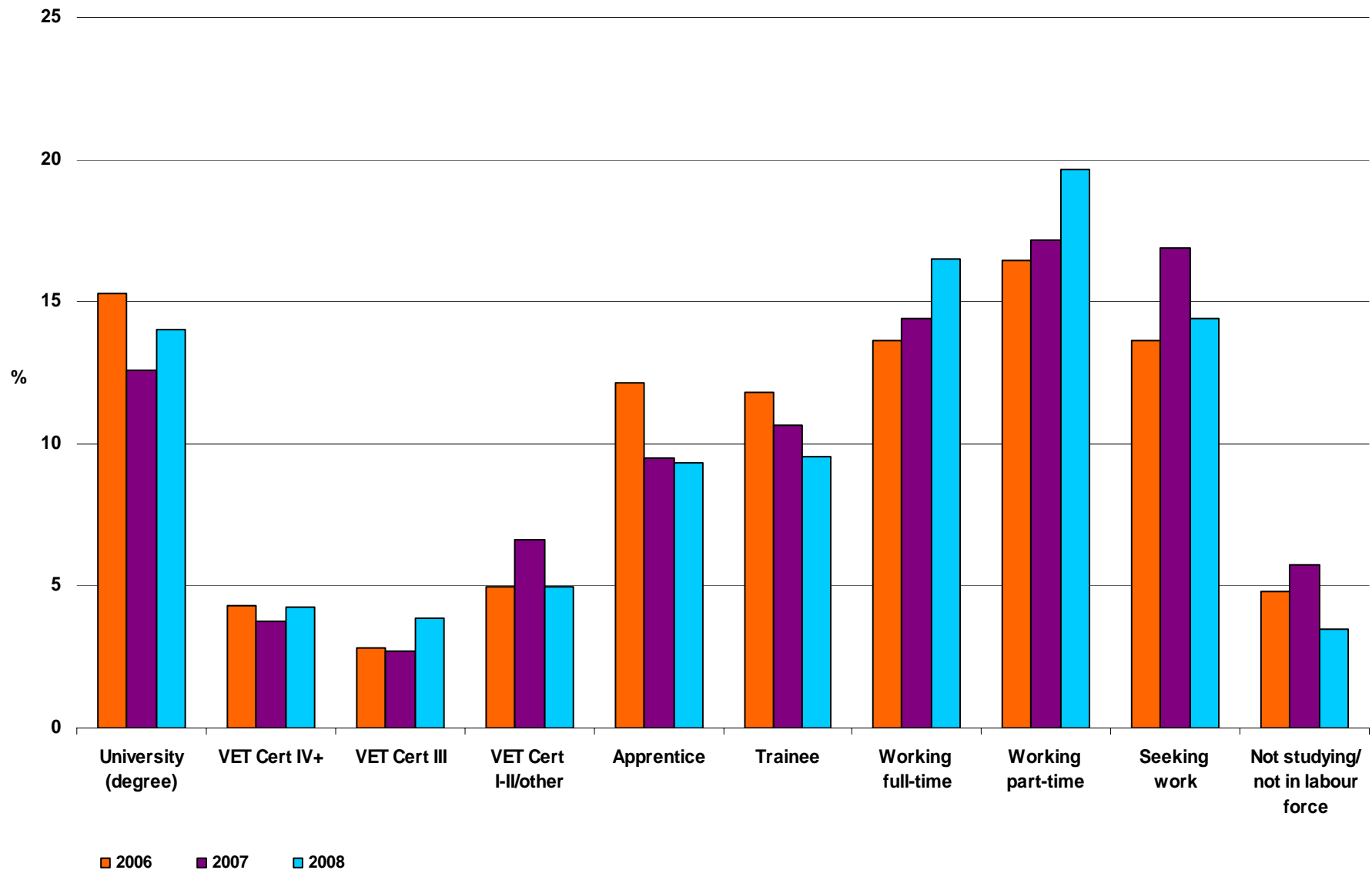
Main destinations by Indigenous status, Queensland 2008



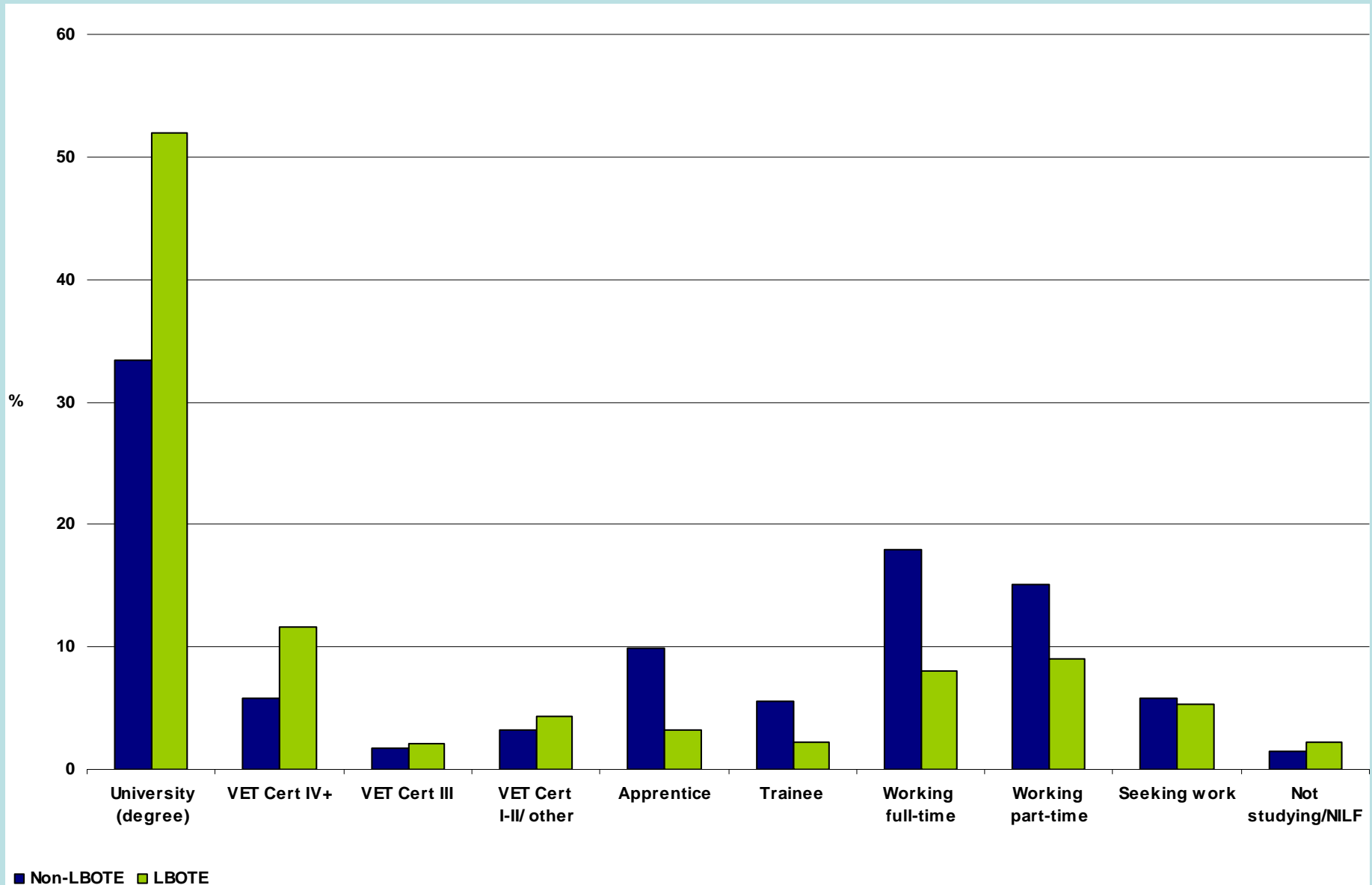
Indigenous destinations by region, 2008



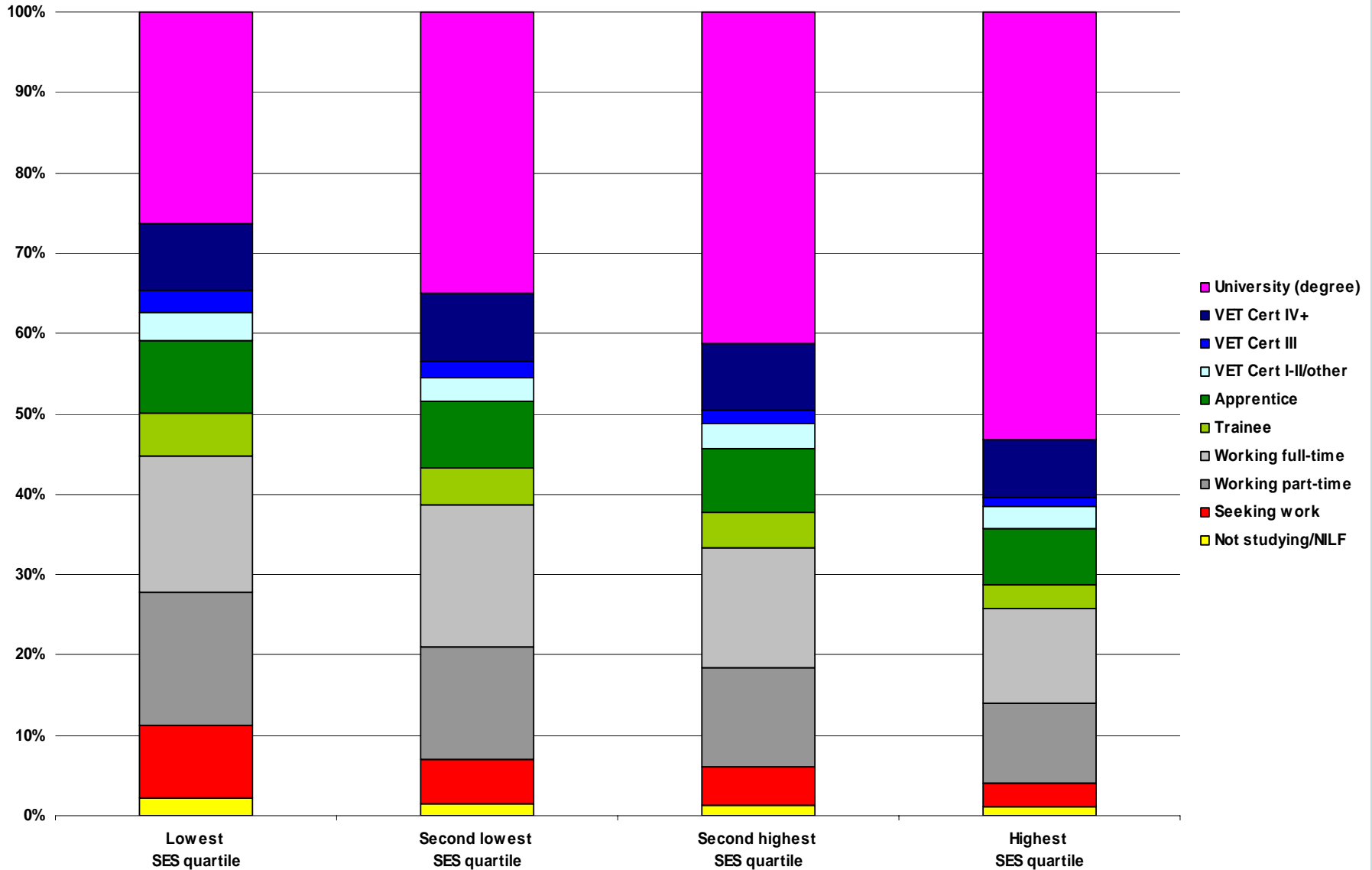
Indigenous destinations, Queensland 2006–08



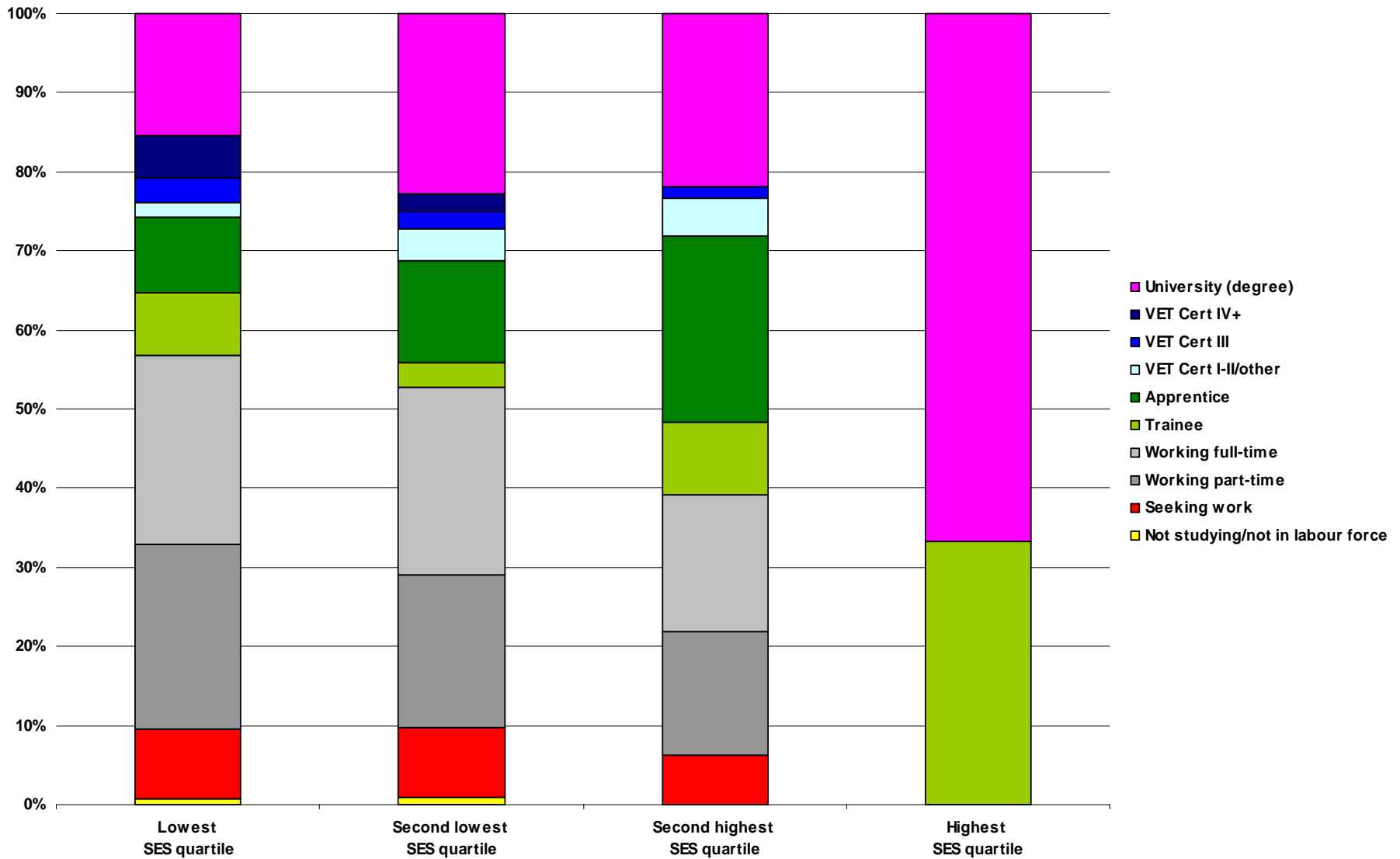
Main destinations by LBOTE status, Queensland 2008



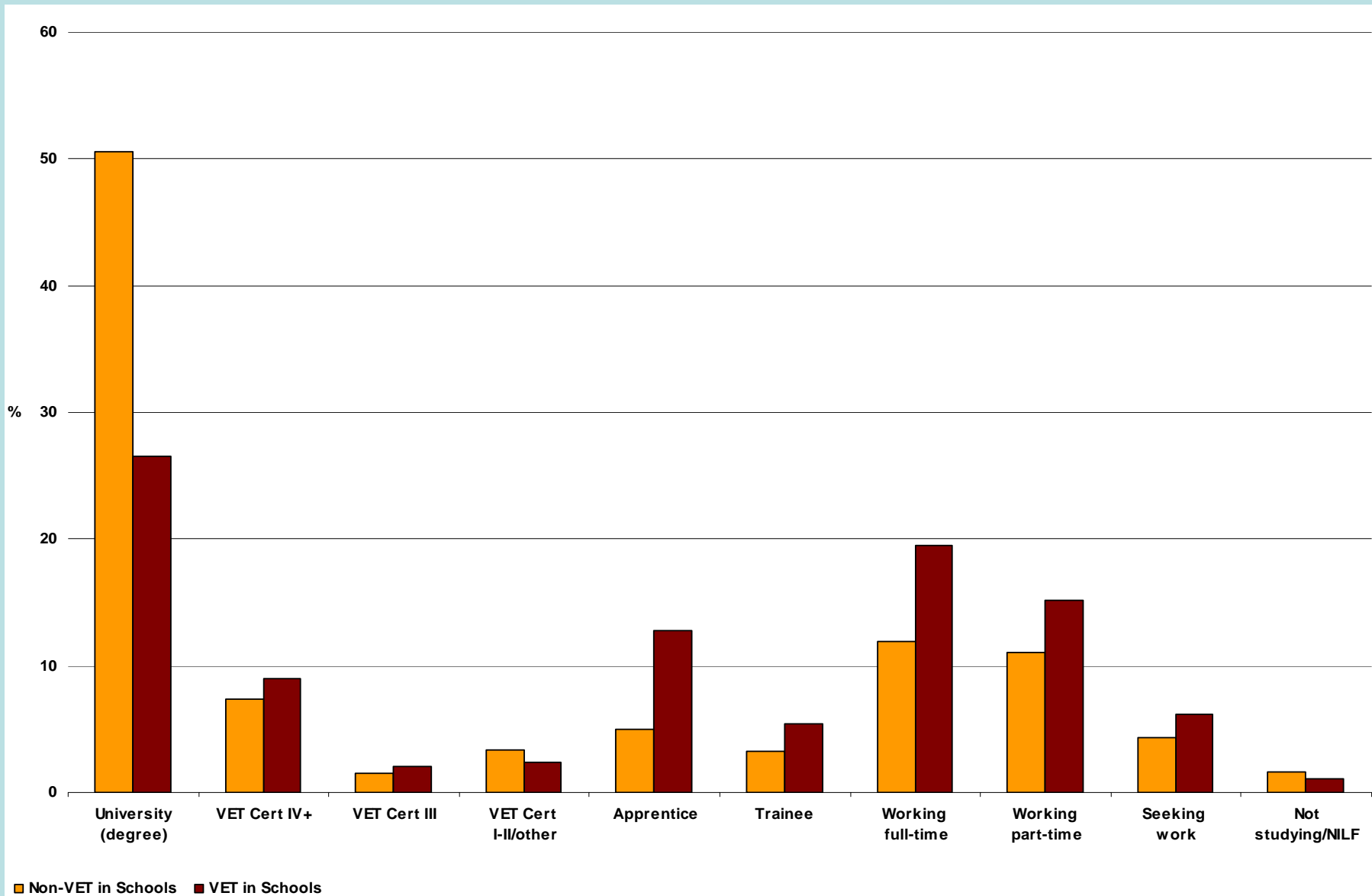

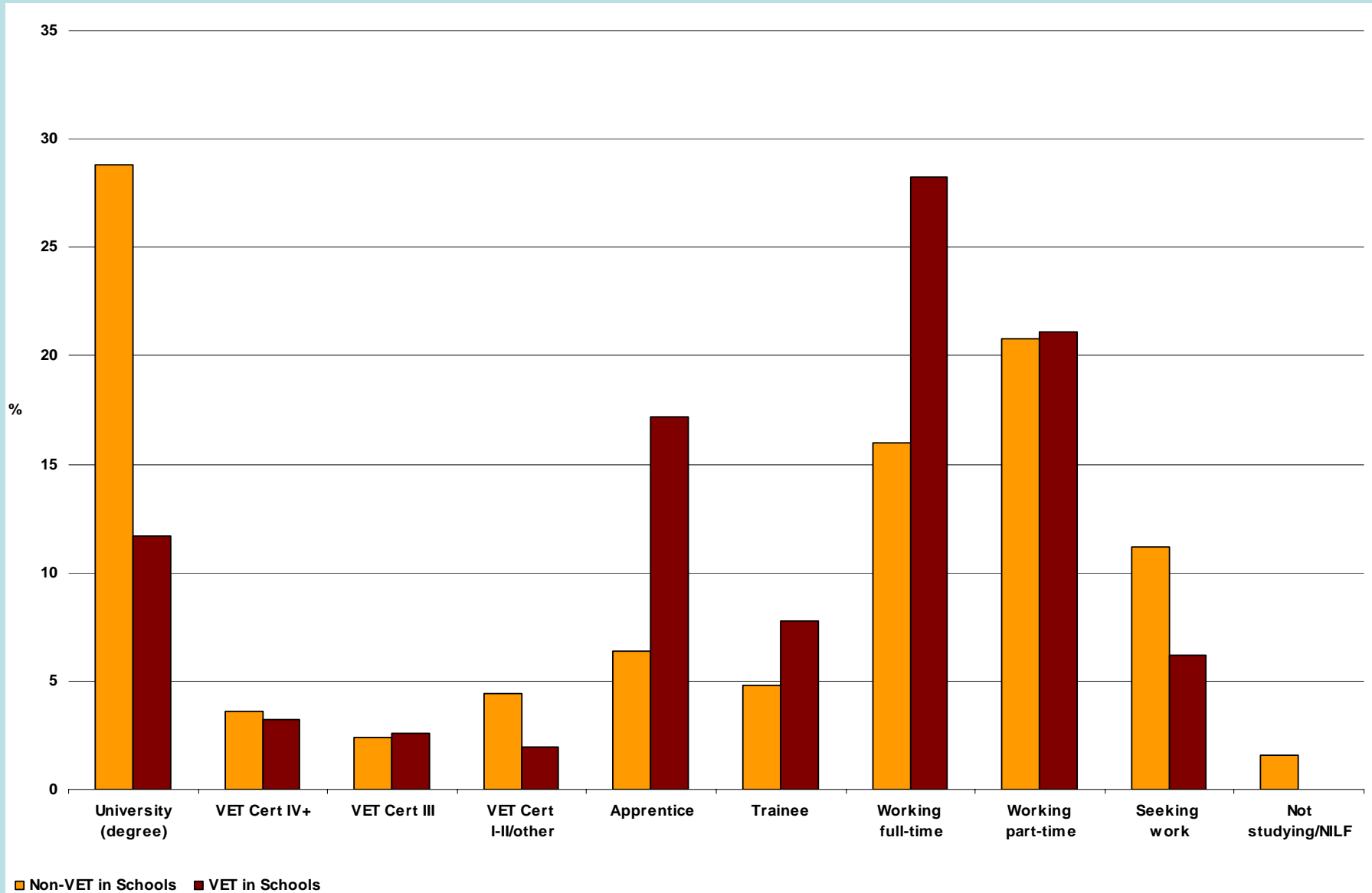

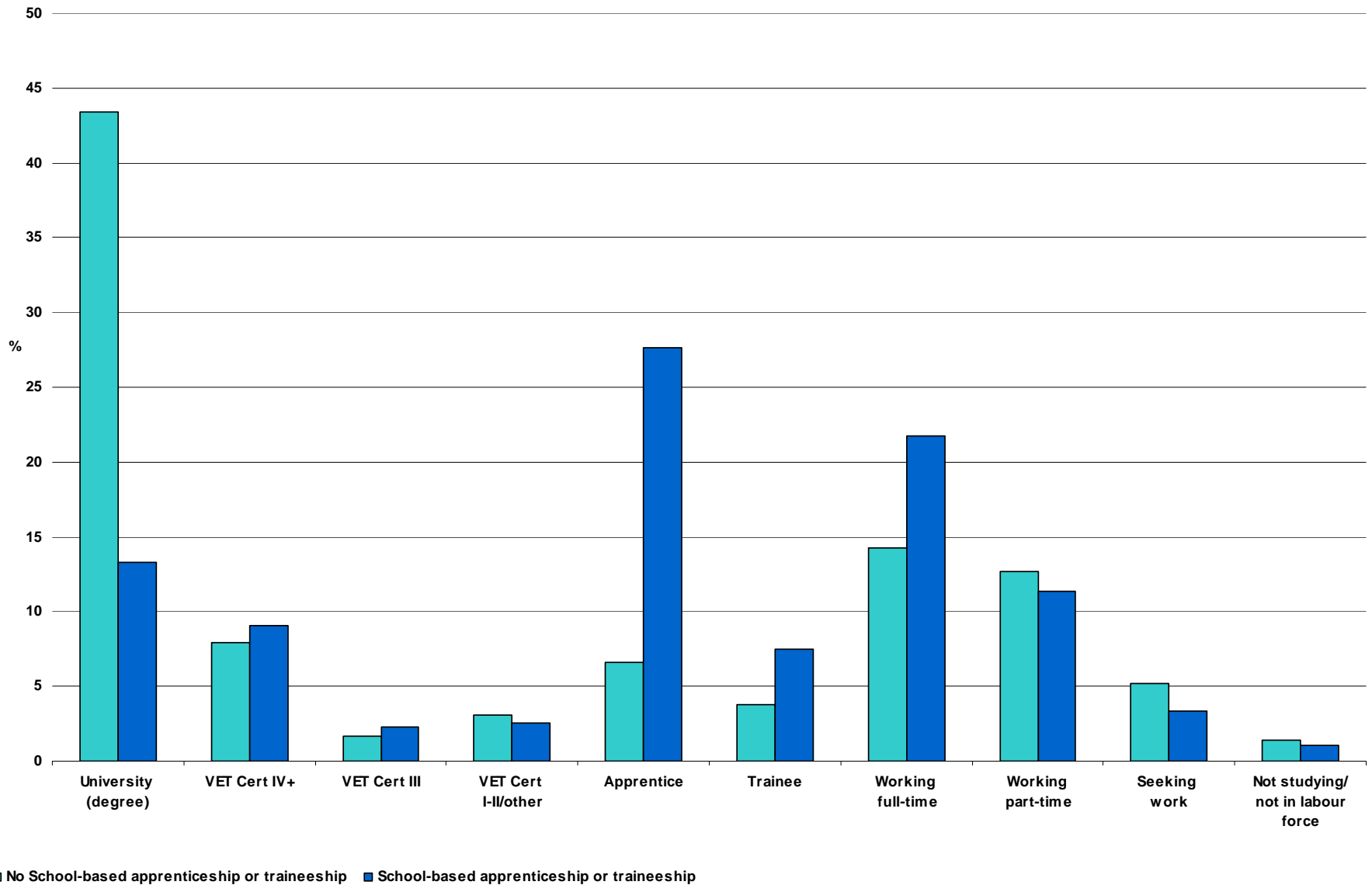
Main destinations by VET status, Brisbane Statistical Division 2008



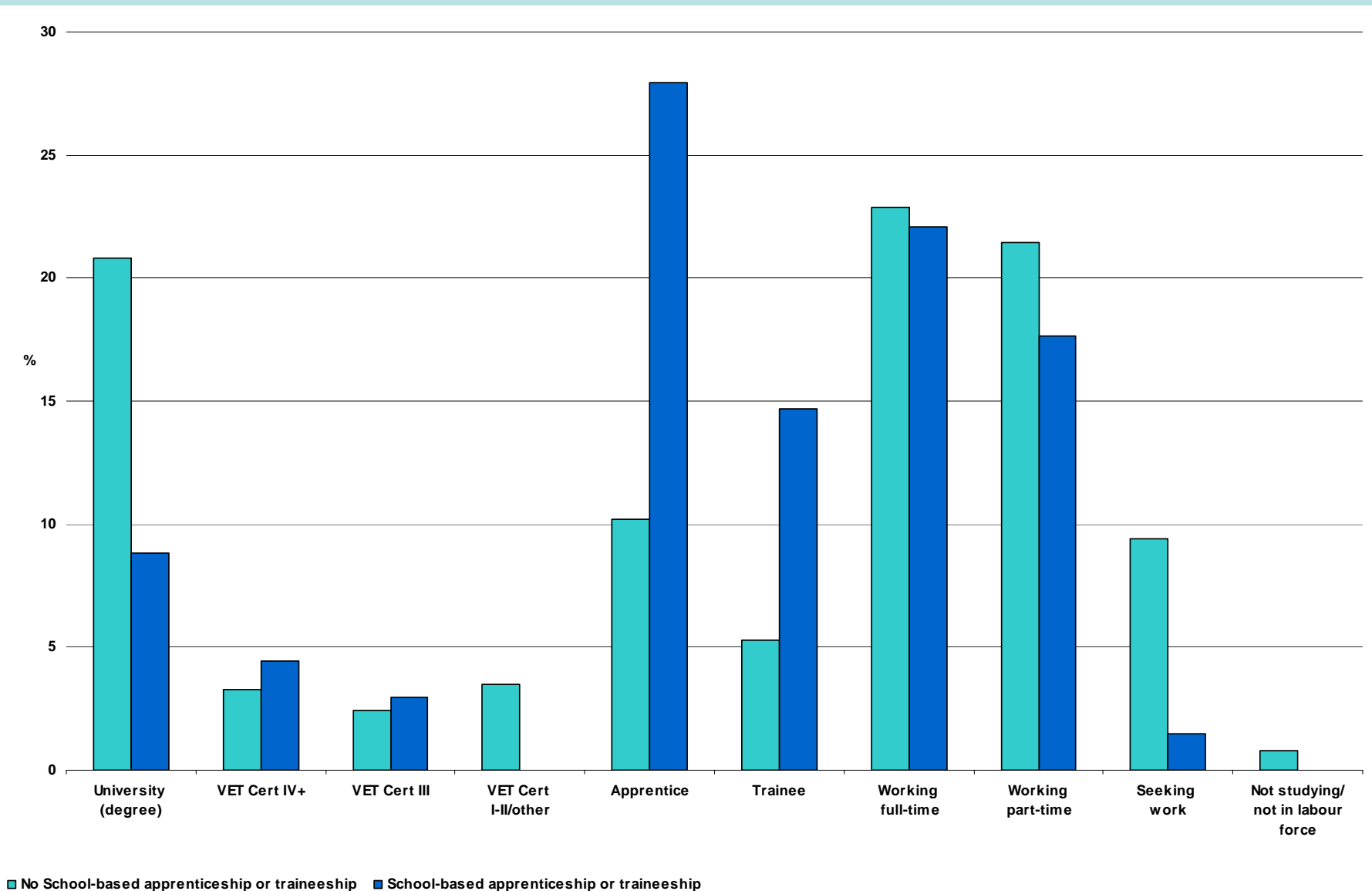

Main destinations of School-based Apprentices and Trainees, Brisbane Statistical Division 2008

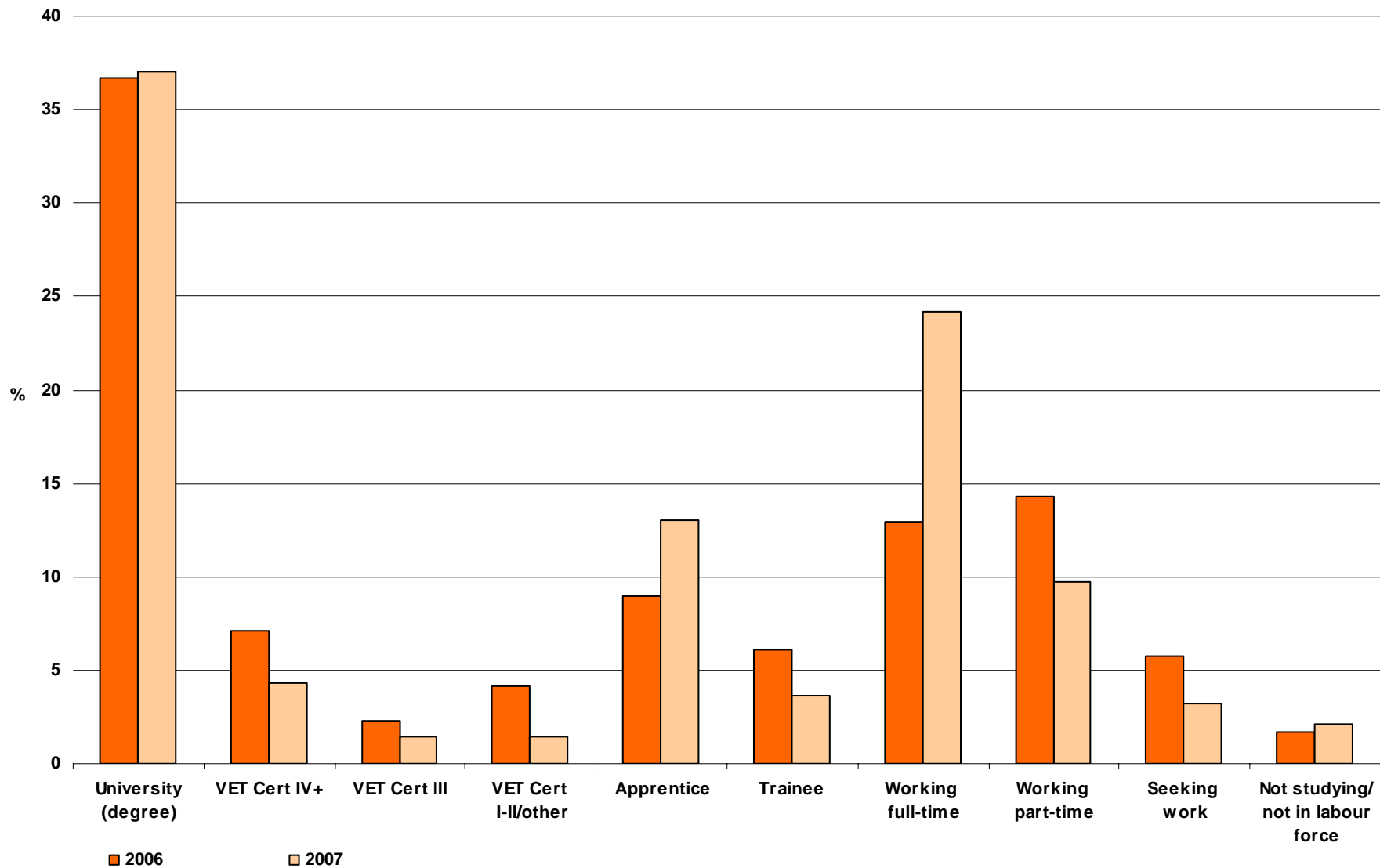

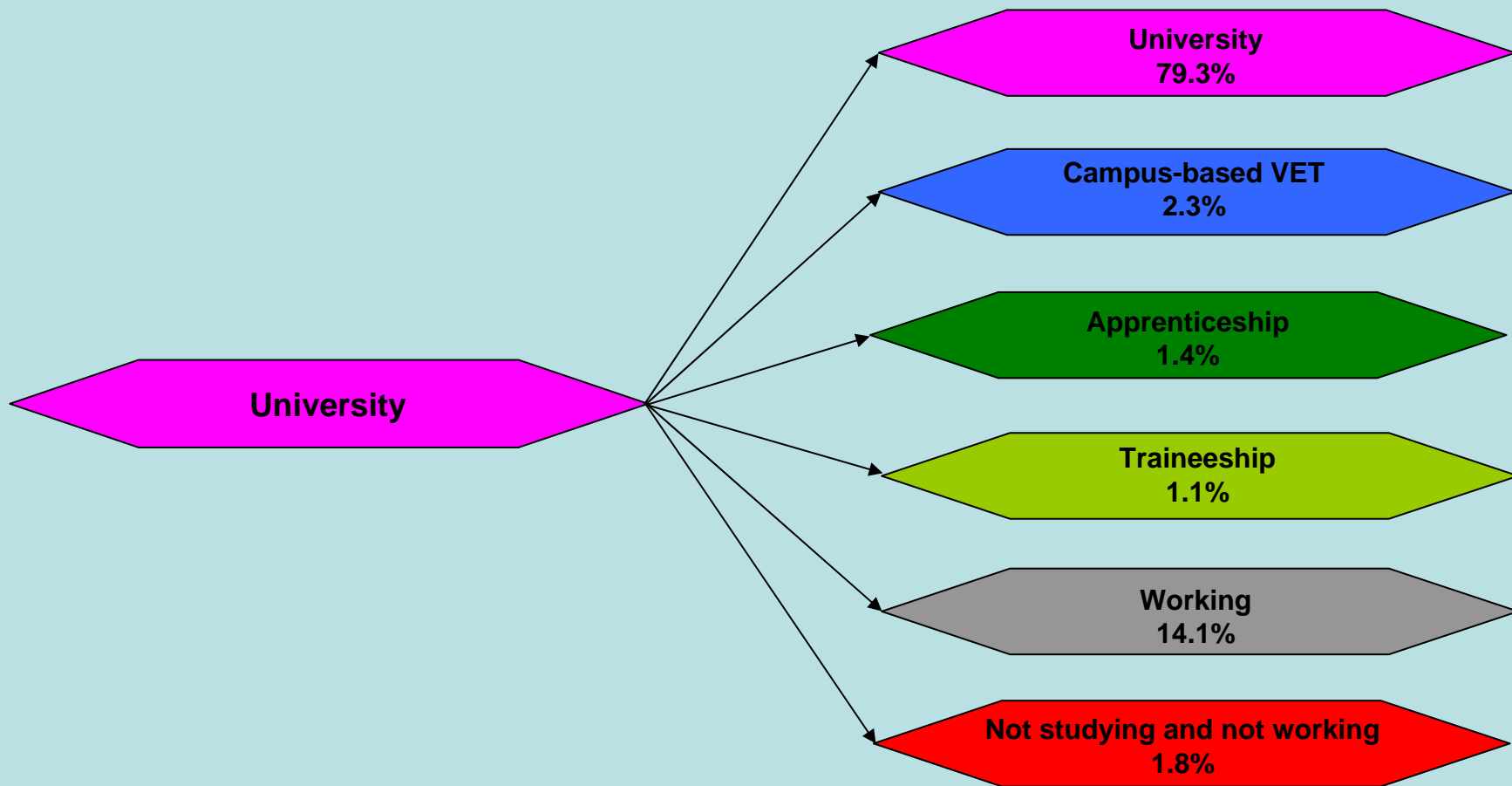
Main destinations of Year 12 completers from 2005, Queensland 2006–07

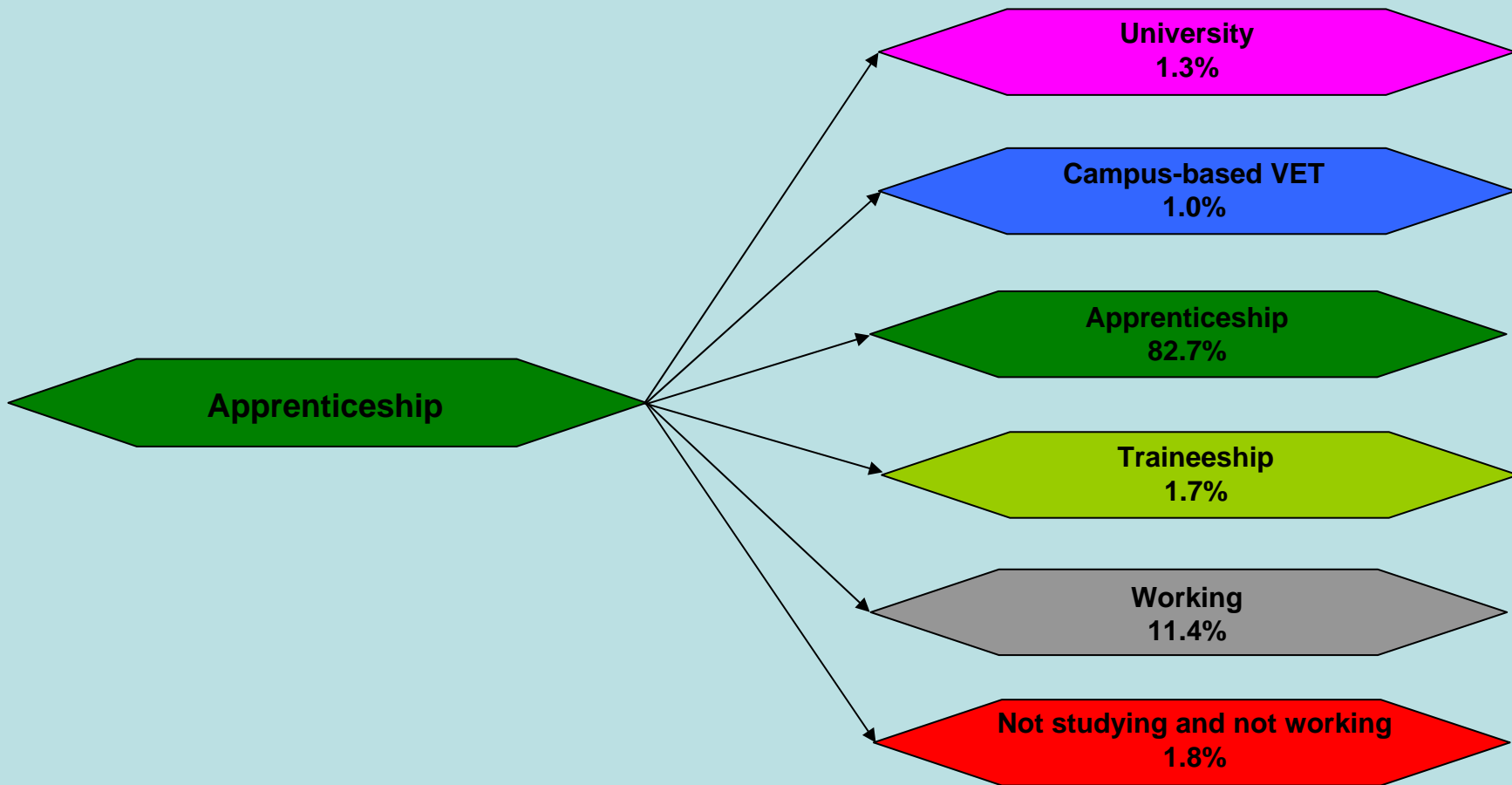

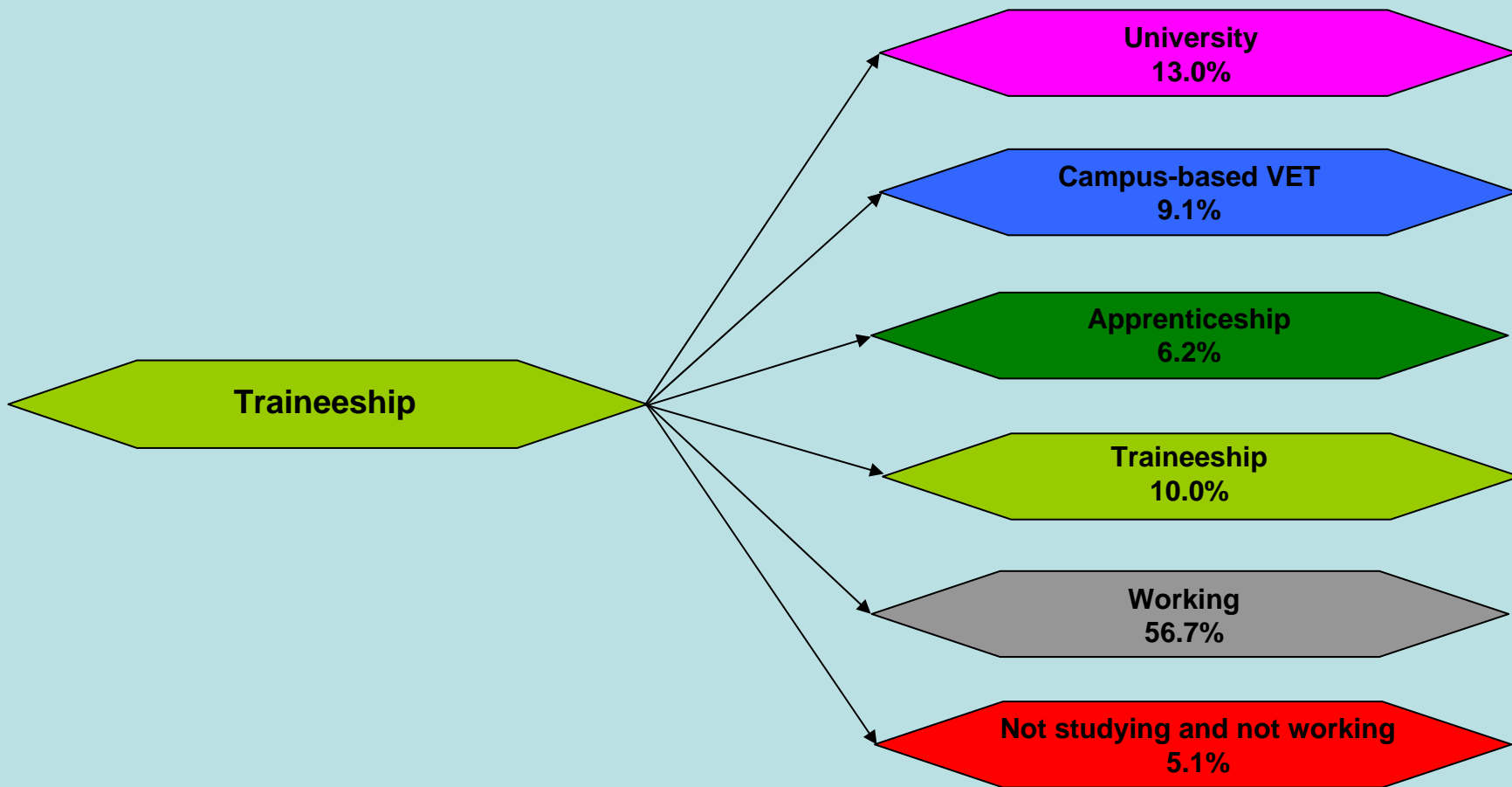

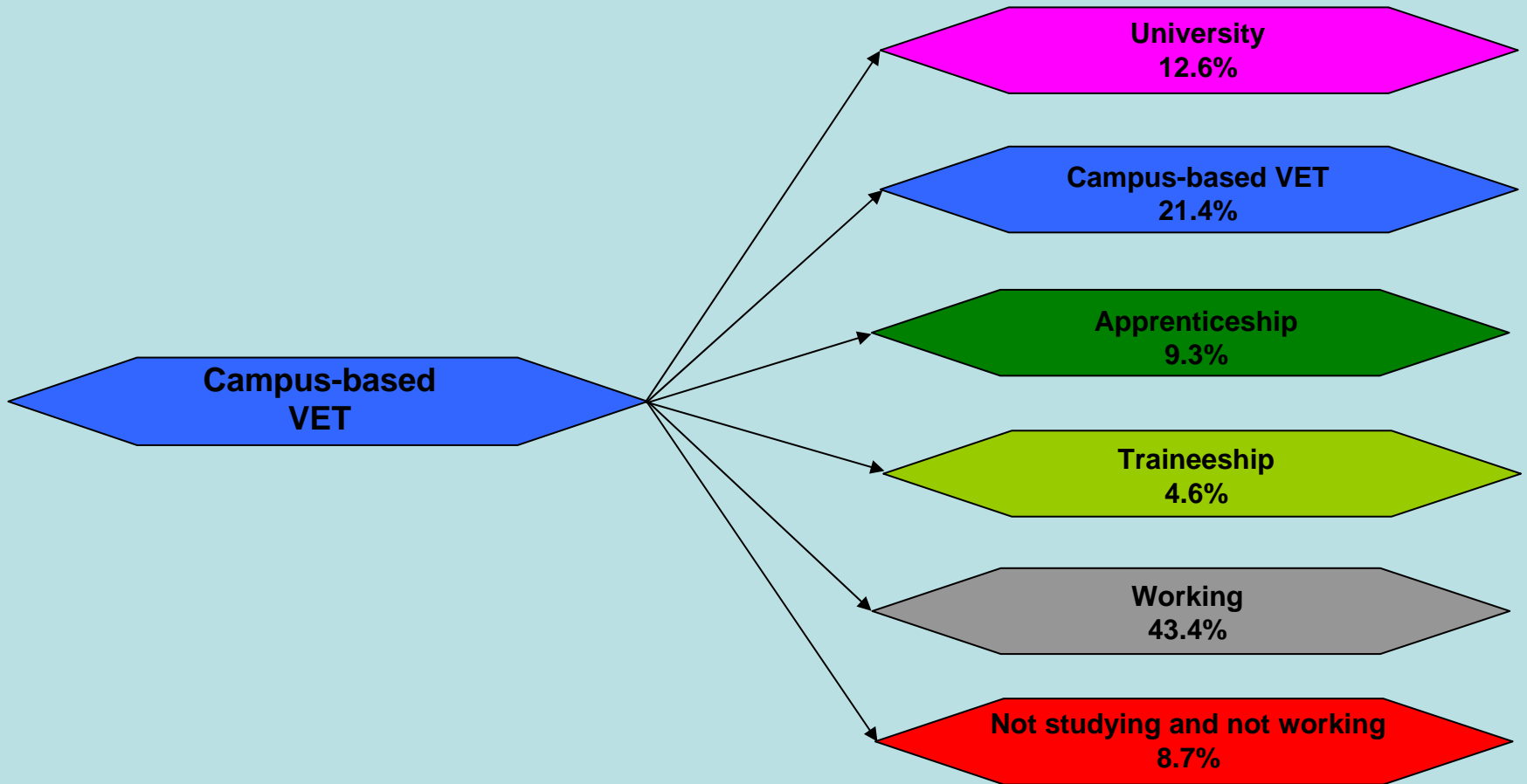

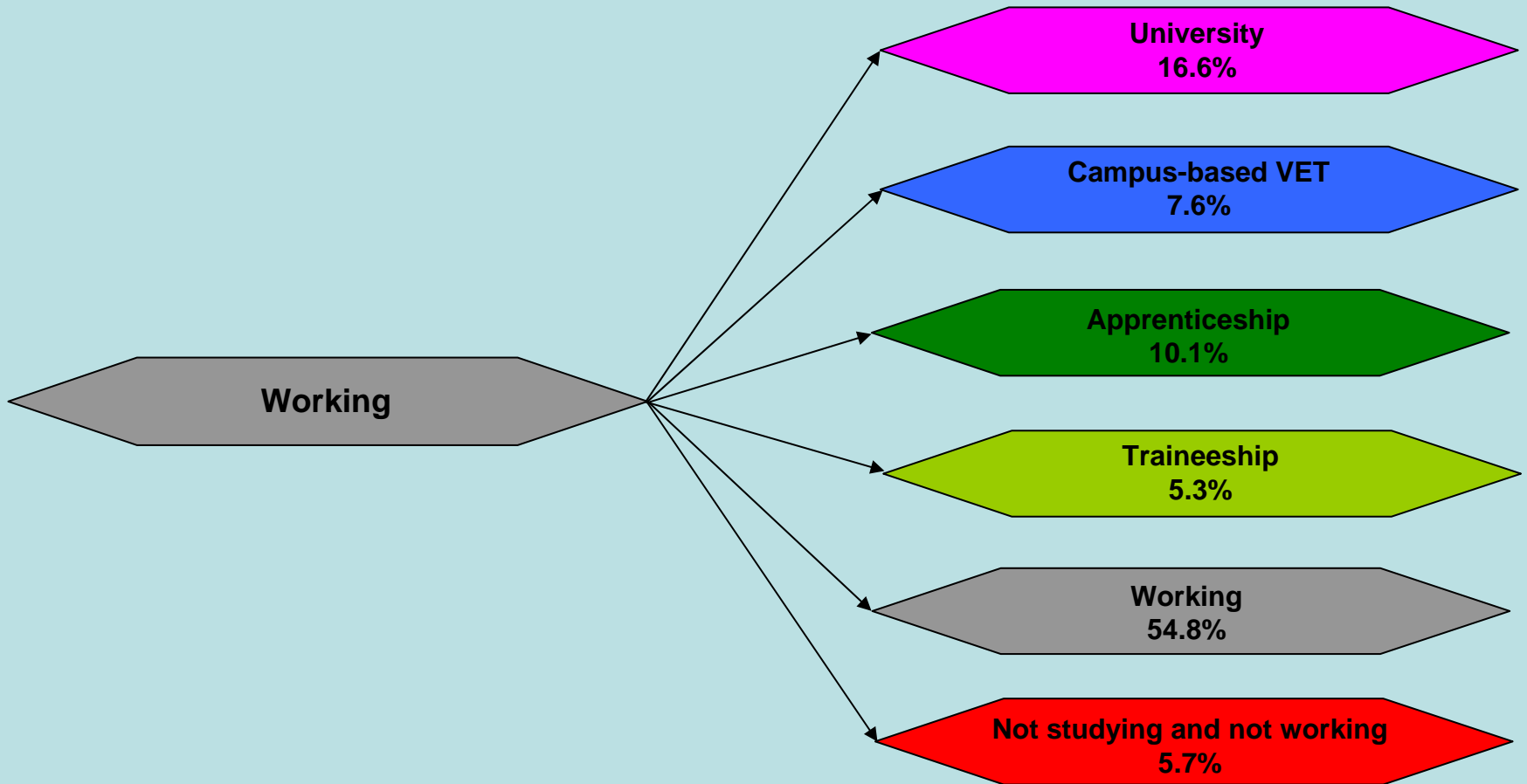

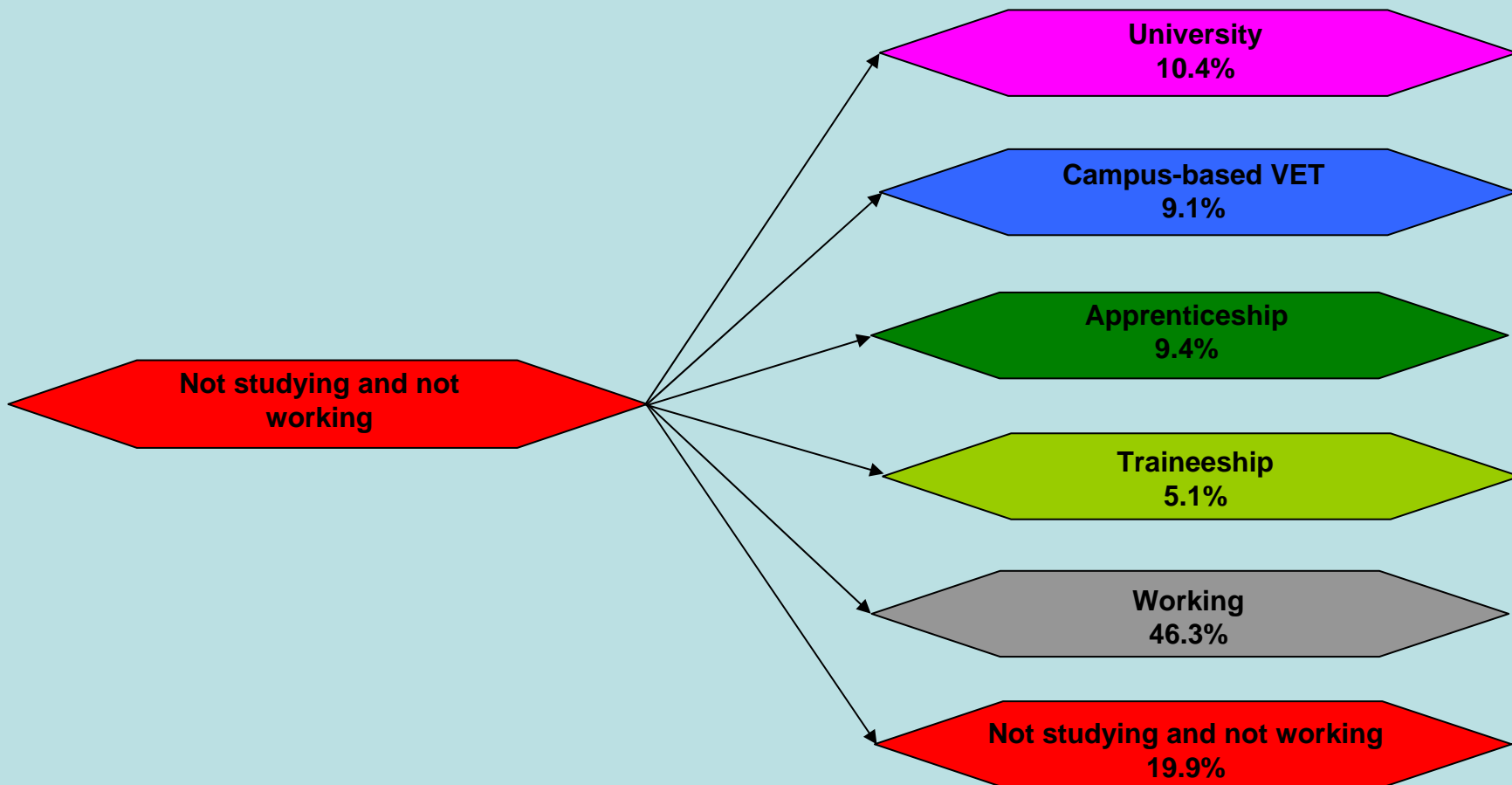

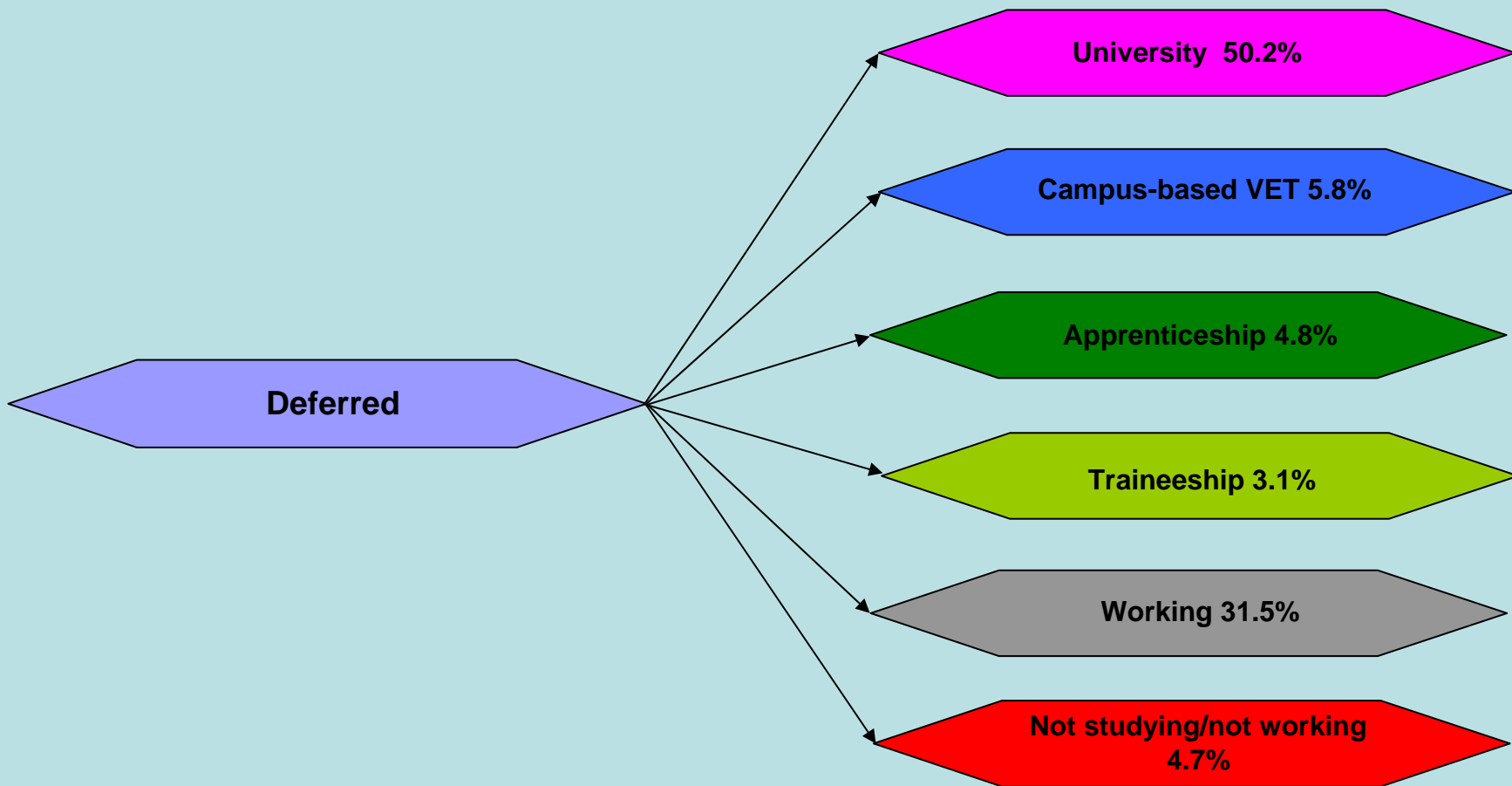
