

2011 INDIGENOUS LIGHTHOUSE GRANT RECIPIENTS**▪ Slade Point State School - *Growing our culture, art and bush tucker***

This project extends the school's strong Indigenous culture by developing a bush tucker garden using art and languages, involving students, Indigenous artists and the local community.

▪ Vulcana Women's Circus - *Southside Dreaming*

Vulcana Inc. in partnership with Inala Wangarra and Southside Education will develop students' team building and leadership skills through a series of workshops and performances.

▪ Gondwana Choirs - *Gondwana National Indigenous Children's Choir, Cairns 2012*

This project will provide regular music education for local choristers and a variety of artistic and professional development opportunities for local musicians and music educators.

▪ Mirndiyan Gunana Aboriginal Corporation - *Mornington Puppetry Project*

Workshops and performances will see students working collaboratively with Elders to re- envision traditional stories of Mornington Island, combining traditional transfer of knowledge with practical contemporary arts training and development in dance, music and puppetry.

▪ Urangan Point State School - *Yurangan Cultural Learning Program*

This project will engage local Butchulla Elders and other community members to promote cultural leadership skills and create a Connecting Cultures resource to sustain Aboriginal history and networks across the school and community.

▪ Ailan Traks Ltd. - *Ailan Traks Railway Histories*

This project will develop a social website using an arts based approach to gather and share stories, educate and offer training opportunities to young people.

▪ Contact Inc. - *Dance Traks*

This collaborative arts and cultural project involves a workshop program exploring dance and fashion culminating in a performance at the Queensland Performing Arts Centre
