Your résumé (also known as CV). This should include details of your secondary school education and any other qualifications or achievements including any previous tertiary education, such as copies of your current academic results. **NB: Your application will not be considered if you do not attach your current academic results**

A written personal statement of no more than 300 words, describing what you want to achieve by studying at university, and how this might assist you to contribute to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

- Two (2) written references. The references should give an indication of your motivation and ability to undertake tertiary study, and should state the nature of the relationship between you and the referee and how long they have known you. One reference must be from an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person.

 - Proof of your Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander heritage. This must include a letter with the stamp seal from an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander community organisation.

 - Copies of any documentation which you feel will support your application. For example, if you plan to study externally it would be wise to submit a statement setting out your reasons for studying externally and why you think you will succeed as an external student.
