



# Parent and Community Engagement Framework

## — At a glance

### 1. What is the Parent and Community Engagement Framework?

The *Parent and Community Engagement Framework* supports schools to engage with parents and communities, to work together to maximise student learning outcomes.

It identifies what schools can do to strengthen learning outcomes for students — through effective partnerships between principals, teachers, students, parents and the community.

### 2. Why do we need a Parent and Community Engagement Framework?

Queensland state schools already work with parents and the community. Research and experience tells us what kinds of engagement make the most difference to student outcomes. The framework looks beyond the traditional engagement activities to strategies that make a difference to student outcomes. Through the framework, all state schools are encouraged to strengthen their approaches to parent and community engagement.

### 3. What are the five key principles identified in the Education Queensland *Parent and Community Engagement framework*?

The *Parent and Community Engagement Framework* identifies what schools can do to strengthen learning outcomes for students — through effective partnerships between principals, teachers, students, parents and the community. The framework is based around five key principles:

- Communication
- Learning partnerships
- Community collaboration
- Decision making
- Participation

### 4. Who was consulted during the development of the *Parent and Community Engagement framework*?
