



## FTE Students at Queensland State Schools, by Year Level

### Reports and statistics – Day 8 Collection

- The number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students in Queensland state schools continues to increase. From 2009 to 2011, student numbers grew overall by 1.1 per cent.
- A total of 484,789 FTE students were in Queensland state schools on Day 8 2011.
- In 2011, 310,104 FTE students (64 per cent) were enrolled in primary year levels and 174,685 FTE students (36 per cent) were enrolled in secondary year levels, including a small number at Continuing Centres for Secondary Education (CCSE).
- The student numbers were reported by schools on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of school for 2011.
- These numbers exclude students enrolled at Special Schools and Schools of Distance Education.
