



Indigenous Enrolments at Queensland State Schools, by Year Level

Reports and statistics - February Collection

- A total of 40,793 full-time Indigenous students were enrolled in Queensland State Schools as at February 2010.
- This represents a 17 per cent growth in enrolments of Indigenous students from 2006 to 2010. This growth is partly attributable to the progressive introduction of the universally available Prep Year.
- In 2010, 27,010 students (66.2 per cent of state school Indigenous students) were enrolled in primary year levels and 13,529 students (33.2 per cent) were enrolled in secondary year levels. There were 254 Indigenous students (0.6 per cent) enrolled in special schools.
- Prep trials were conducted in 2005 and 2006, and a half cohort of Prep was introduced in 2007 to align with the shift in the compulsory school starting age from 2008. The first full Prep cohort commenced in 2008. The introduction of the universally available full-time Prep program replaced the part-time preschool program in Queensland.
