



Enrolments at Queensland State Schools, by Region

Reports and statistics – August Census Collection

- A total of 484,615 full-time students were enrolled in Queensland state schools in August 2009.
- Enrolments in Queensland State schools continue to increase. From 2005 to 2009 enrolments experienced an overall growth of 7.5 per cent. This growth is partly attributable to the introduction of the universally available Prep Year.
- Around a quarter (26.1 per cent) of state school students were enrolled in schools in the Metropolitan Region, followed by South East (21.4 per cent) and North Coast Region (21.3 per cent).
