



Enrolments at Queensland State Schools, by Region

Reports and statistics – August Census Collection

- A total of 485,798 full-time students were enrolled in Queensland State Schools in August 2010.
- Enrolments in Queensland State Schools continue to increase. From 2006 to 2010 enrolments experienced an overall growth of 6.8 per cent. This growth is partly attributable to the introduction of the universally available Prep Year.
- Around a quarter (26.3 per cent) of state school students were enrolled in schools in the Metropolitan Region, followed by South East and North Coast Region (each 21.4 per cent).
