



Enrolments at Queensland State Schools, by Region

Reports and statistics - February Collection

- A total of 491,459 full-time students were enrolled in Queensland state schools in February 2011.
- Enrolments in Queensland state schools continue to increase. From 2007 to 2011, enrolments experienced an overall growth of 2.5 per cent.
- Around a quarter (26.3 per cent) of state school students were enrolled in schools in the Metropolitan Region, followed by South East and North Coast Regions (both around 21 per cent).
