## Section 8: Employment Location Preferences

DET operates a state-wide staffing process for state school teachers and it is a condition of permanent employment that teachers may be required to teach anywhere in the state at some stage during their teaching career, regardless of their location preferences for initial appointment.

*Bid O’Sullivan Teaching Scholarship* recipients are required to teach initially in a rural/remote location under the terms of the scholarship. Applicants should demonstrate flexibility in their location preferences, and are asked to provide details of their availability to work in various locations throughout Queensland. Please indicate your preferred locations for your initial appointment at this stage. You will also have an opportunity to indicate your preferred locations for employment as part of the Application for Teacher Employment process.
