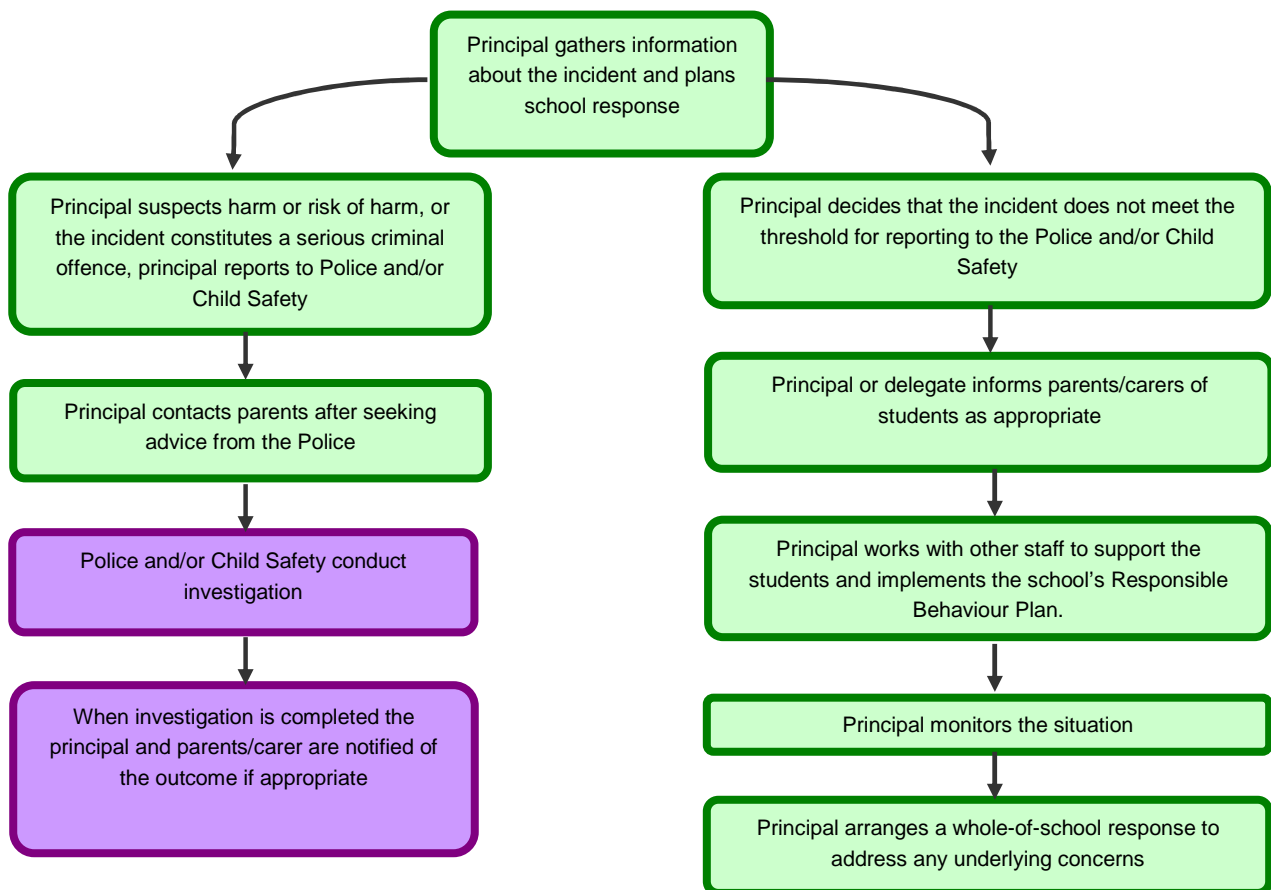


What happens when... a student harms another student?

Education Queensland is committed to providing safe, supportive and disciplined learning environments for all students. All staff complete student protection training and are required to report suspicions of harm or risk of harm to the principal. When a principal becomes aware that a student has harmed another student, the principal takes the following actions:



A student who has been harmed by another student, or the parents/carers of that student, can also make a report to the Queensland Police Service when the incident that caused the harm may be a criminal offence.
