The Department of Education International, in collaboration with RSL Queensland, is proud to deliver the Premier's Anzac Prize an esteemed annual award that provides a life-changing opportunity to explore Australia's Anzac history and legacy.

Each year, outstanding Queensland Year 9–12 students take part in activities that build their knowledge and understanding of the Anzac spirit and its relevance in modern Australian and global contexts. Recipients have the unique opportunity to participate in hands-on workshops, research fundraising projects, and community engagement sessions. Recipients' engagement with the Anzac legacy then comes to life during a two-week tour of significant memorial sites in the United Kingdom and on the Western Front in Belgium and France.

This prize not only provides an opportunity to connect with the history and contributions of the Anzacs but also fosters intercultural understanding, helping to cultivate empathetic and socially responsible global citizens.

Prize details

- Awarded to Queensland high school students and teachers from both state and non-state schools.
- A 2-week tour of Europe visiting key sites important to Australian war history.
- Recipients learn about *life at the front* and the history of Anzacs overseas during WWI.
- Recipients attend a 3-day workshop hosted by State Library of Queensland, complete a research task, undertake a charity fundraising project and other community events.
- Recipient teachers accompany the group and assist with projects as well as undertake their own research task.
