and short vowels

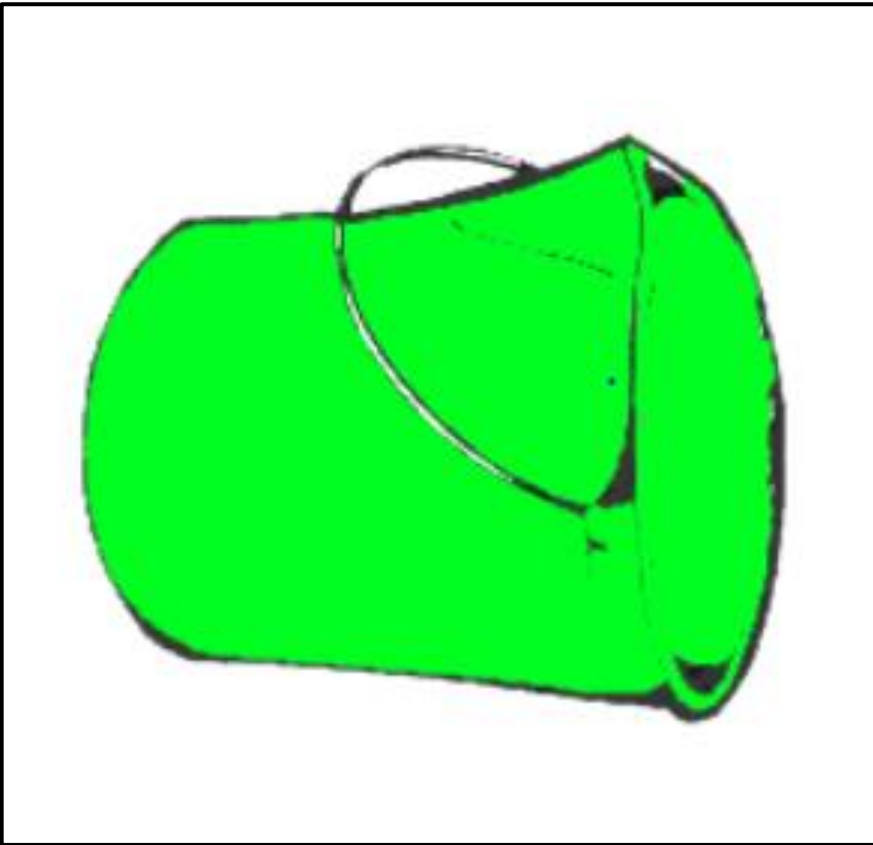
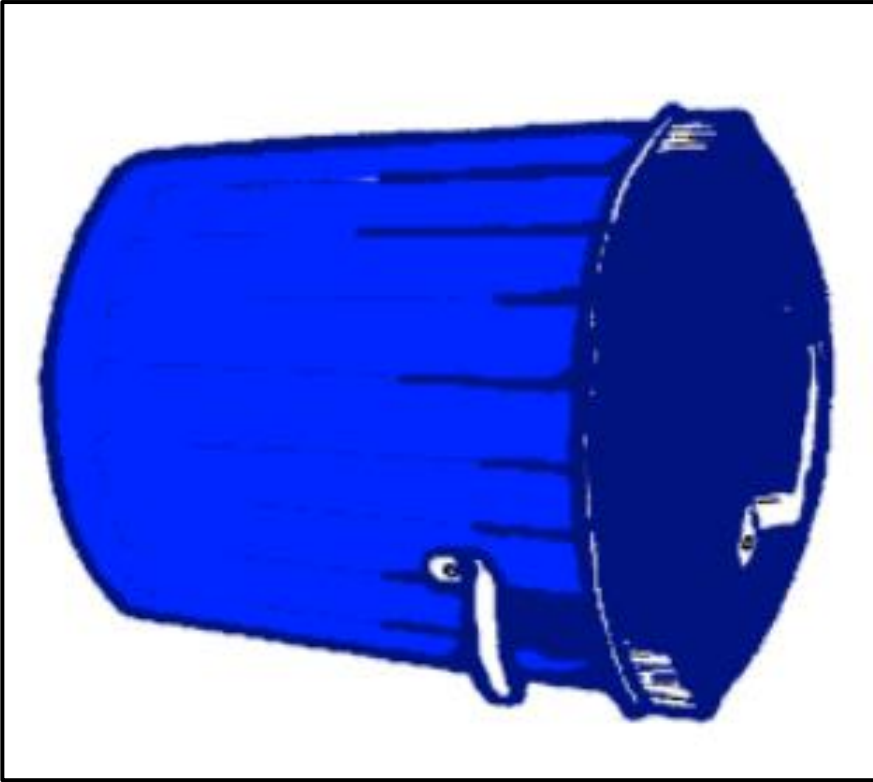
A **digraph** is **two** letters
that represent **one** sound
e.g. sh, ch, ng, th.

Decoding regular one syllable CVC words with short vowels
CVC = **consonant** – **vowel** – **consonant** e.g. **bat**, **lock**, **much**, **fish**
