


Health, safety and wellbeing governance structure

The ability of all employees, particularly those in leadership positions, to make informed decisions on health, safety and wellbeing (HSW) matters, is key to the effective execution of individual duties and responsibilities.

A key mechanism for the provision of assurance is a defined and robust health, safety and wellbeing governance structure.

This is to be achieved through the formation and conduct of health, safety and wellbeing committees and other forums at department, region and workplace levels, as well as at branch level where appropriate.
