



2023 Queensland Global Teacher Program to Osaka, Japan

4 - 17 January 2023 (excluding travel)

INFORMATION

Since 1988, the Department of Education and the Osaka Prefectural Government have partnered to deliver international education programs. In 2023, five Queensland state school teachers will have the opportunity to travel to Osaka to undertake Japanese language professional development. The program will run from 4 to 17 January 2023 (Summer school holidays).

Queensland teachers looking to enhance their knowledge of contemporary Japanese culture and improve their language proficiency are encouraged to apply. This program is open to all state school teachers of Japanese language or teachers who hold a Japanese Language Proficiency Test rating of N4 or higher.

The successful applicants will study at the Japan Foundation: Japanese Language Institute, Kansai where they will undertake professional development activities and be given the opportunity to visit places of cultural and historical interest in and around Osaka.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Motivation for applying for the program
- Perceived benefits of professional development
- Proposed benefit to students and school community
- Principal's endorsement

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The application form, including Parts A and B, must be completed in full and submitted to Global Opportunities by the closing date
- Attach scanned copy of the photo page of applicant's passport or evidence of a valid passport application
- At the completion of the program, participants must be willing to write a report on his/her professional development experience/s
- Applicants must meet all requirements of the Terms and Conditions outlined within the application form to be eligible to apply.
