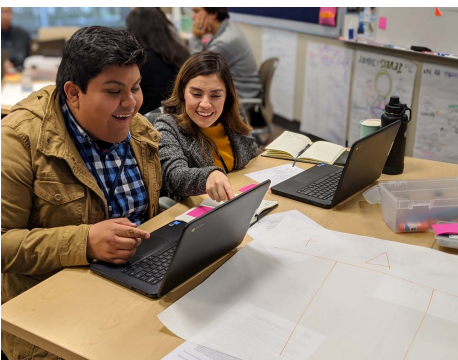
- Online interactive program over three half-days via Zoom
