Growing Global Competence Fund

The Growing Global Competence Fund (GGCF) provides Queensland state schools with the opportunity to apply for funding to develop projects that grow global competence within their school communities.

Administered by the Global Engagement team, schools can apply to access tiered funding in increments of \$2,500 up to a maximum of \$15,000 for a project to take place in 2025.



The GGCF is underpinned by the Global Competence Framework. Schools applying for the GGCF will use the framework to help define their project goals, parameters, and measurable outcomes.

Eligibility

- Funding is available to Queensland state schools only
- One application per school (applies to both single and multi campus schools)
- Schools may submit individual applications or partner with other schools for a collaborative project

How to apply

- Eligible schools can apply online
- To submit an application and access supporting resources, schools should search 'Growing Global Competence' on OnePortal

Criteria

Applications will :

- align with the Global Competence Framework
- have measurable impact and legacy
- develop capability of both staff and students

- Applications open - 3 February 2025
- 1st Information session - 24 February 2025
- 2nd Information session - 12 March 2025
- Applications close - 4 April 2025
