## Eligibility requirements:

#### Students must:

- Be an Australian citizen, permanent resident of Australia or a New Zealand citizen residing in Australia.
- Be a full-time Year 4, 5 or 6 student at a Queensland state school in 2026.
- Have an interest in learning another language.
- Have access to a stable internet connection, PC, laptop or tablet, headset or headphones (with microphone) and a webcam.
- Be available to participate in the program for five consecutive days during the January 2026 school holidays.
- Have Parent/Guardian consent to submit an Expression of Interest.
- Have a letter of endorsement from a teacher to submit an Expression of Interest (in the form of an email or written letter detailing behaviour and work habits).
- Submit an Expression of Interest by 5:00 pm on the closing date via the Online Application Portal.

### **Privacy Statement:**

The Department of Education (the department) is collecting the personal information you provide on this form for the purpose of administrating the Global Passport: explore the world in 5 days (the program) application process.
