The Department of Education (the department) has transitioned Queensland state schools to the [Students with disability – Reasonable adjustment resourcing \(RAR\)](#).

Support services to non-state schools

Supports provided to non-state schools by departmental officers, including Advisory Visiting Teachers, have not changed.

The department continues to provide supports and services to non-state schools, as outlined in the *Memorandum of Agreement—Special Education Services and Dual Enrolment 2023 - 2025* (the Agreement).

The department will continue to provide the following services to non-state schools throughout 2023, 2024 and 2025 as outlined in the Agreement:

- Education Adjustment Program (EAP) verification for the categories of hearing, physical and vision impairment.
- Advisory Visiting Teacher services for students in the EAP categories of hearing, physical and vision impairment, including supporting non-state schools to complete EAP verifications.
- Equipment loan and trial service.
- Vision impairment services.
- Dual enrolment program options.
- Hospital education program service.
- Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability cross-sector moderation.
