
The AEDC is a national census of early childhood development at the time children commence their first year of full-time school.









- 3 SEIFA Quintile 1: Socio-Economic Indexes for Area (SEIFA) Quintile 1 refers to communities experiencing high levels of socio-economic disadvantage (lowest 20% of SEIFA scores).
- ⁴ Remote: Children living in remote/ very remote areas.
- ⁵ The word Indigenous refers to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people of Australia.
- ⁶ Transition indicators: percentage of Queensland children whose teacher answered 'very true' (2021).
